Message

In June 2019, Jammu & Kashmir smiturked on a unique initiative "Back to Village". The project was both deunting and ambitious - a public outreach of this size and scale had never been attempted before, certainly not in a state-like Jammu & Kashmir with its unique problems of geography, climate and law and order.

Undownted by the skeptos and the naysayers we decided to go altest with the programme. The response of the programme exceeded our own expectations. Everywhere the visiting officers were welcomed, letted and homoured. The affection and respect with which officers were received across geographies was, for us, a testimony to the masse goodness and hospitality of the common people. The officers spent two days and a regiment the people-living with them, nating the same food and learning first hand the challenges and difficulties of their existence. For many it was a unique learning expenence—the sweet ions of nature brought home to them the beauteous forms of things: for others was a numbing experience as it lied term to them the dignity which the rural population lives, notwithstending the myriad challenges of their existence. Such was the entitusiasm generated by the programme that a resident of thopian District wrote to the Hombie Prime Minister about this programme following which the Prime Minister made a mention of it in his Mann is South Programme calling it a festival of development, public periodistion and public awareness:

Encouraged by the success of the first edition of the programme, we have now decided to embark on its second phase. While the first phase of the programme was focuseed on collecting feedback and assessing needs, the second phase intends to look more closely at the task of empowering, energiaing and institutionalizing the functioning of Panchiryati Raj Institutions, invariably they will associate Panches/Serpanches. The other objective of this edition of the programme will be to look at the various flagship programmes and individual, berieficiary oriented schemes and learn more about the impediments grievances, which hampers their full implementation and their disposal also be ascertained. The visiting officers would also study agriculture and affed activities in the Panchayass, particularly with the objective of our national goal of doubling farmers, income by 2022.

I am confident that our entire team will once again rise to the occasion and replicate the success of the first edition of the programme. I am also confident that the Deputy Commissioners and Administrative Secretaries will create the necessary conditions for the visiting officers to dischinge their role effectively. I am equally sure that this programme will evolve into an institutionalized, doorstep, governance programme which will not only be a genuine, unadulterated ear to the ground but will also cut the infamous red tape and help in delivering development better and faster.
