I	Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):
1.	Water Supply scheme at Quittinard / Dangamard & upgradation of existing network of pipes etc for providing portable drinking water to whole panchayat including Sheikh Mugam.
2.	Construction of Aloosa - Lolab road via Nagamarg
3.	Upgradation of Infrastructure of middle school Chichimar, Bentipora, Helmutipora etc by construction of new classrooms, toilets & boundary wall.
4.	Lift irrigation facility & Dam at Khodran
5.	Proper transmission & distribution of electricity by installing electric poles & laying powerlines.
6.	Sanction of Anganwari Centres for Sheikh Mugam Bala, Sheikh Mugam Payeen & Chichimar
7.	Sanction of Forest Check post & Sale Depots.
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
	→ Lack of Portable drinking water. (nallah water / unfiltered supplied directly through pipes) → Smuggling of timber & firewood from forests due to lack of Forest Check Post.

III	Overall perception of functioning of the government:
	Barring few departments, there is utter failure of Civil Services by most of the Govt. departments due to either deficiency of staff, lack of funds or official apathy.
IV	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:
	(the visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)
	Little participation & lack of enthusiasm among people was noted due to non-fulfillment of promises made during B2V-1 programme. There is a strong feeling of dejection & betrayal among people. It is suggested that the demands during B2V1 & B2V-2 programme are addressed & resolved before the exercise is repeated in future.
