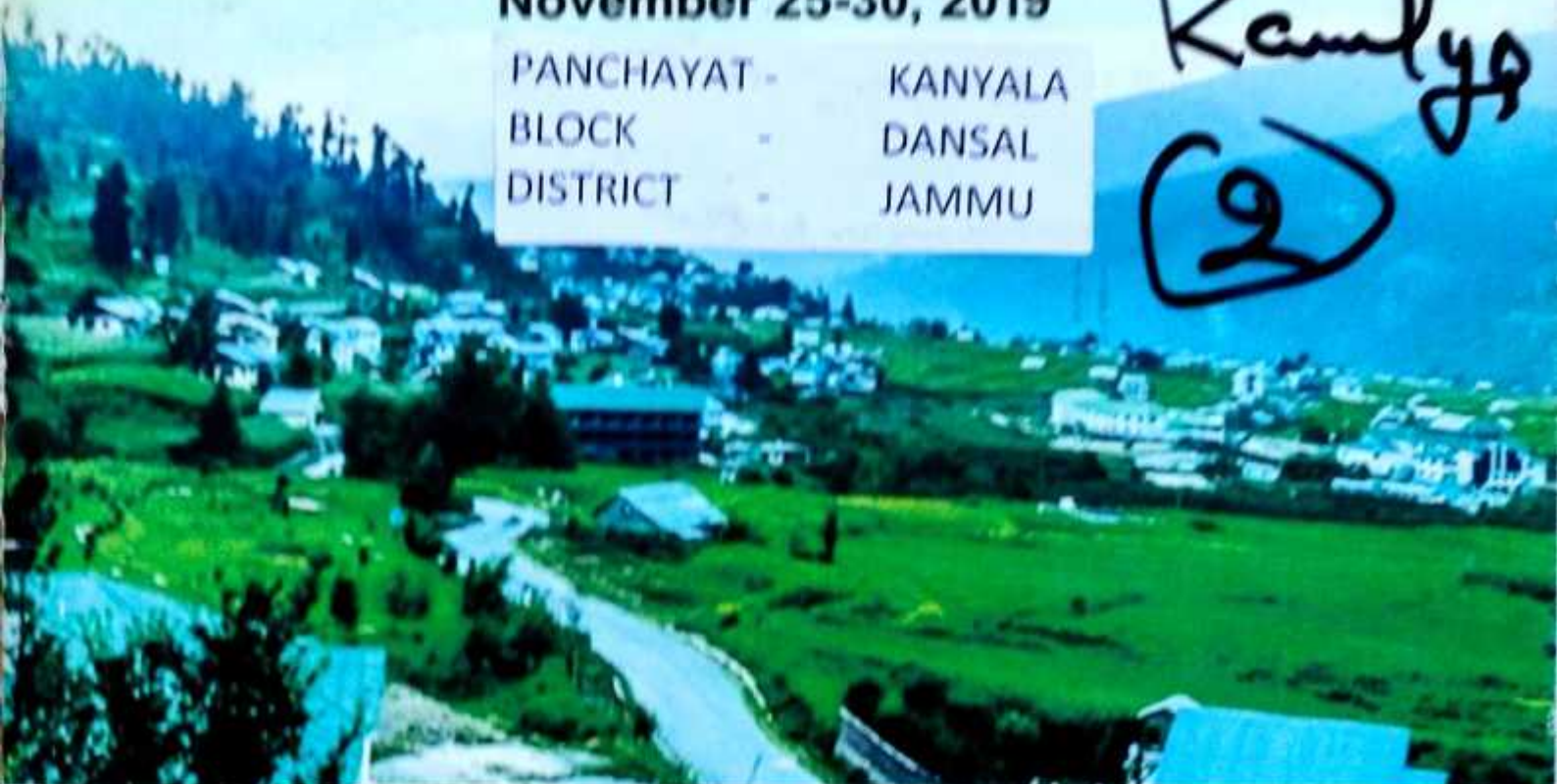

III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

During the stay in the Panchayat under B2V2, it was observed that the Panchayat is far behind the other areas in the Block in respect of basic amenities for the people. Some Deptts such as Agriculture, RDO, PDD, ICOS Education are performing upto the expectations of the people of the Panchayat. Whereas PHC, Irrigation & Flood control, Social Welfare, PWD, Animal Husbandry are lacking in delivering the services for the public. In some areas people get water supply once a week, while other areas also get short supply of water. Water supply is the major issue faced by the public. Some areas are without roads, some have kachcho roads. A lot needs to be done to bring Panchayat at par with other areas in the Block.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

During my stay in the Panchayat under B2V2 programme wef 27<sup>th</sup> of Nov 2019 to 28<sup>th</sup> Nov. 2019, I get opportunity to meet people from every walk of life and visited most of the Panchayat despite of inclement weather. People in the Gram Sabha put forth the problems faced by them. The Panchayat sans basic amenities like Water, Roads, education electricity, pension and nutritional schemes for children. Drinking water supply service is most deficient in the area. In some areas People get water once a week or no water for months together due the negligence of the department.

Regarding Roads, it was seen that areas like Kayarian, Balaran, Pounkhra, Upper Slay are without road connectivity. Till date people have to the walk kms together and pass streams, Nallah to reach the main road at Pohta to board a bus to travel to other places. Condition of the internal roads is very bad. People and specially students have to face hardship to travel during rains. A spot on the road to Kah near Sh. Chamel Singh house is one where school going children don't cross the road in rains.

Regarding Agriculture, main occupation of the people is agriculture and dairying. People practice dry land farming and get low yield. Monkeys destroy most of the crops. There is no sub centre of the Animal Husbandry and Sheep Husbandry deptt in the Panchayat. There is no irrigation facility in the Panchayat. There are nos. of streams and perennial source of water which can be tapped for irrigation purpose. Regarding Education sector, there are Six Pry School, one Middle School and one HS School in the Panchayat. But staff strength is very low. No Urdu teacher in any of the school. School buildings are insufficient to accomodate the students and are in very bad condition. In HS School, toilet blocks are not functional, needs immediate renovation.

There are many cases for widow /Old age and Disability Pension pending in the Panchayat. Very few people know about Ayushman Bharat. Most of cases of PMAY are pending.

People have certain reservations regarding the demands put forth by them in the B2V1. They requested that govt. may redress as many issues put forth by them in B2V2 so that they may also lead a comfortable life as people in other areas.

All the elected representatives of the Panchayat represented their area in a very civilized way. Sh. Amjad Beg, Sarpanch gets all praises for good cooperation and arranging tours to the far flung inaccessible areas for on the spot assessment of govt schemes, schools and roads.

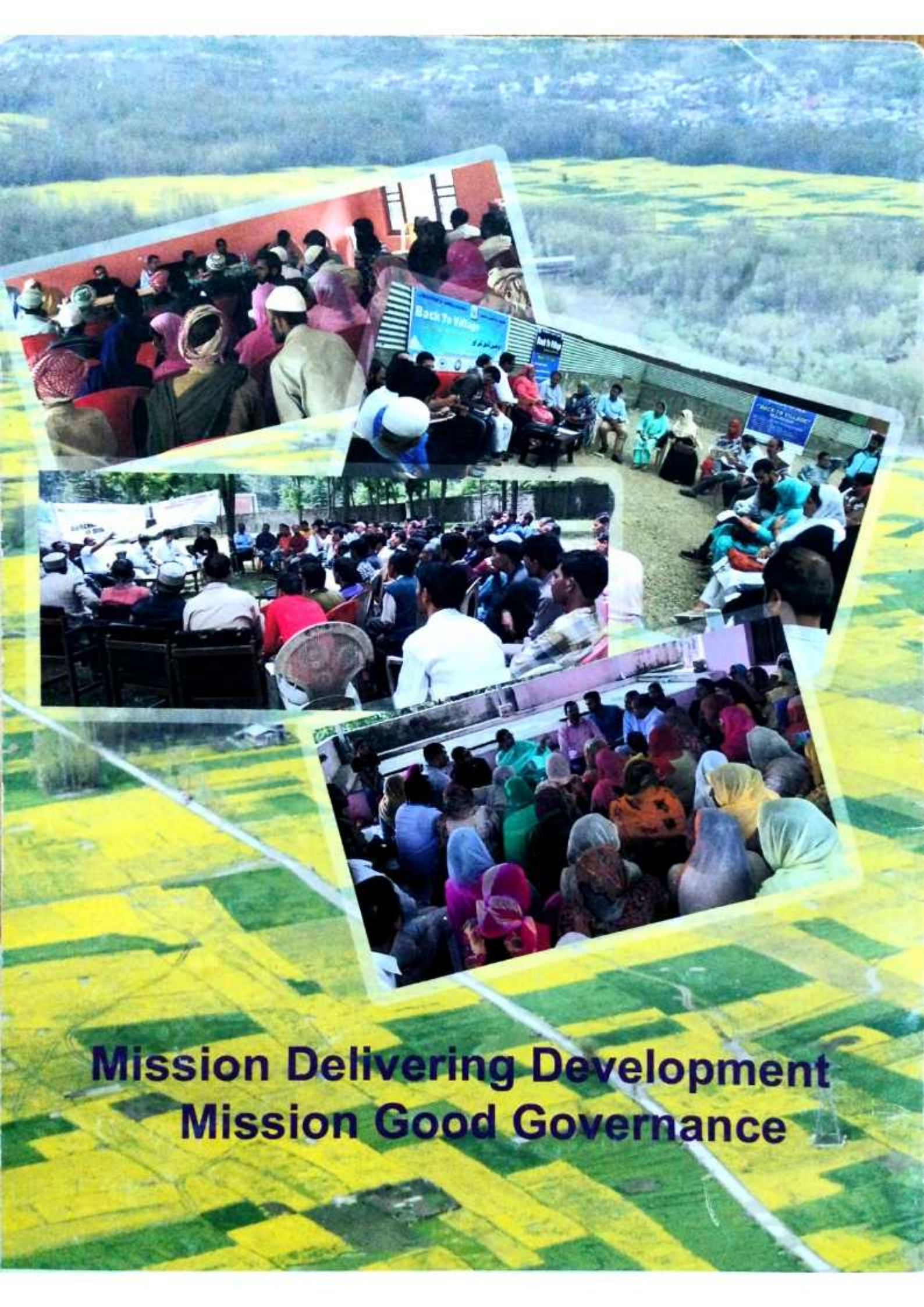
