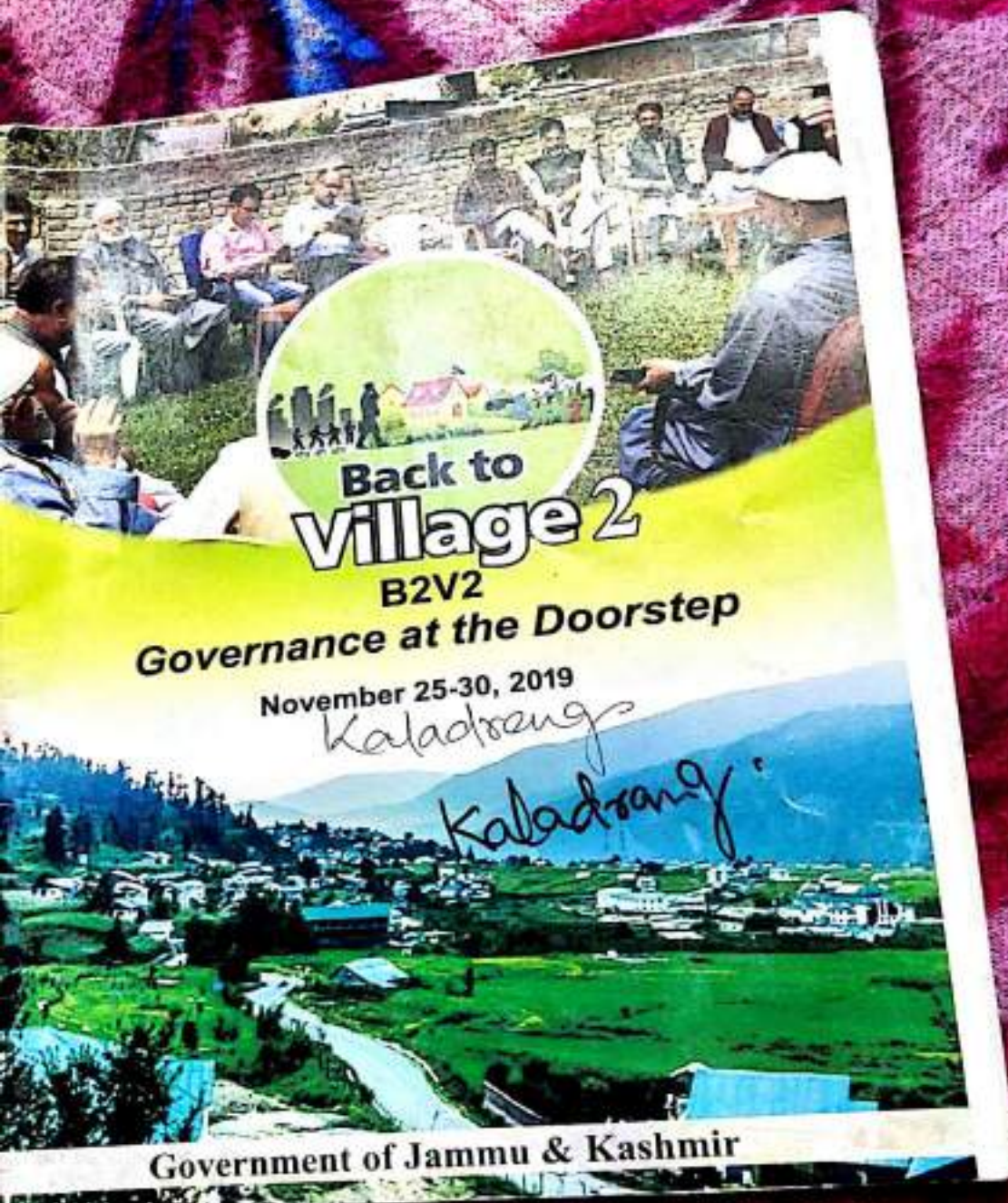

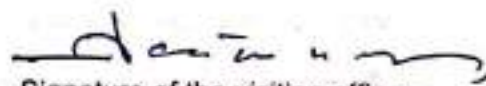

The electricity supply from Mishra to Nandul via Bhatapara falls through densely wooded areas due to which there are often power faults. So the line should be shifted via Ghat to Nandul through Bhatapara by road.

	Being a flood prone area most of the Govt. functionaries / services got damaged frequently. Moreover, B2V1 programme was not implemented properly due to curfew / strikes / hardships and lack of internet.
IV	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:
	(the visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)
	The panchayat (panch/sarpanch) are not elected in the village. Awtak committee is highlighting the issues of Gram panchayat and concerned departments. I hope the assessment / problems and works will be carried without any delay. Rest people showed great spirit.
