As the BDC has been established subsequent up on the village panchayat people do not feel a bit empowerment & take decision pertaining to their need on their own, thus improving the overall functioning of the Govt.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

(The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

"Back to village" programme has generated faith & hope among the people that their grievances will be addressed and attracted with the system process, substantially increased. I hereby suggest that at least 50% of the grievances which were highlighted in the B2V1 booklet should be addressed.
