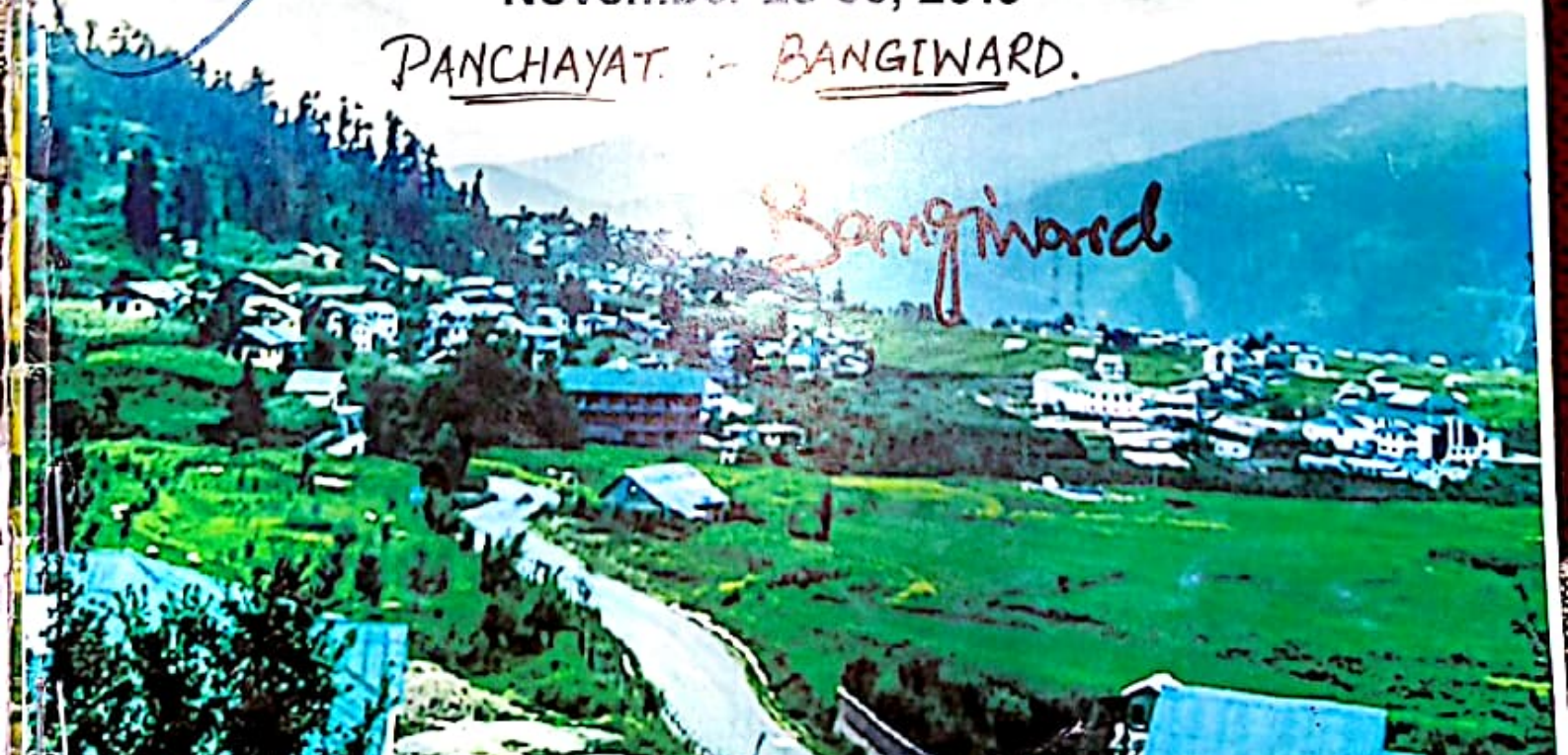

4.	Providing electric power supply with Transformers, Poles & Conductors to Dard Pardian habitation.
5.	Construction of new road for connection of existing two roads, namely Baghal to Dadkun with K.B.Pora to Chok madia road.
6.	Construction of Road from Drang Harampora to Khashing Der up to Mashed Sharief. AND Construction of Road from K.B.Pora to Hazam Mohalla Dard Pardian.
7.	Construction of Drain from Zeyarat Sharief to Bhat Mohalla/Wajayada, including Foot path. Also Construction of Foot Path with R/wall from Ward Mohalla to Bhannard.
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
1.	Insufficient drinking water facility in the Panchayat
2.	Extremely dilapidated condition of existing roads, needs urgent improvement and proper meedamustion.
3.	Insufficient number of ICDS centers because the habitation is scattered over large area. Also Insufficient No. of Distribution centers (CDM) centers.
4.	Deficiency of teaching staff for Middle School Bangward Ballah
5.	Playground not constructed even on availability of Govt. land.

III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

The overall perception of function of the government is Satisfactory. However the funds should be released up to the extent that the demands reflected during BZVI & BZVR could be fulfilled up to the expectation of the public. Further the awareness camps should be organised at Panchayat level for different public benefit oriented schemes of the government.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

The Overall assessment of visit is Satisfactory and should be organised in future. The duration of programme is too less, it is suggested that the duration of such programmes should be extended up to four days for the more participation of public and govt functionaries.
