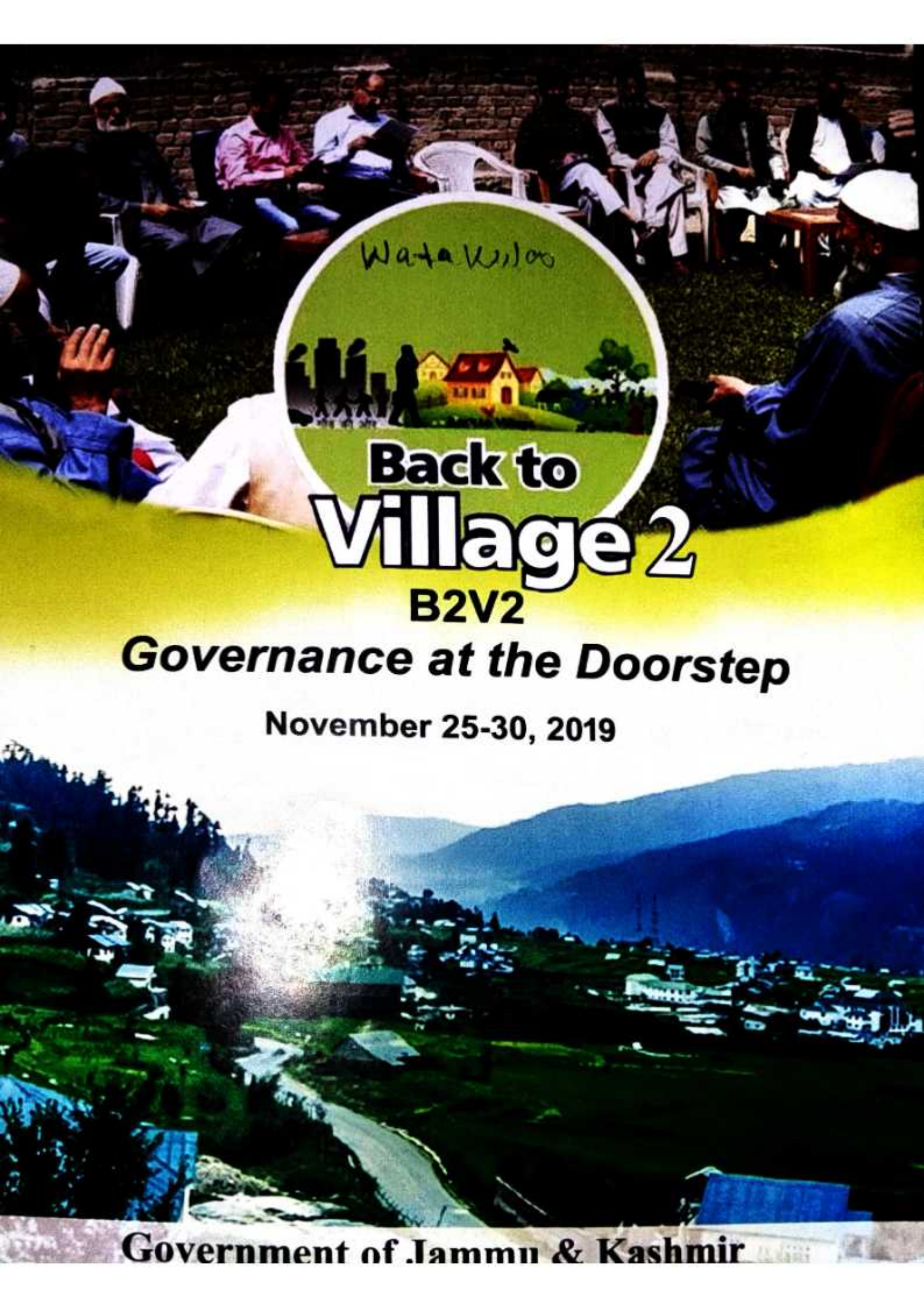

III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

Though various departments of government are functioning in the area but still public in general feels deprived as the basic facilities like health care is still not upto the mark in area.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

(the visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

Though the assessment and suggestions were recorded in booklet submitted in B2V1 programme but it is very unfortunate that these suggestions and demands recorded remain confined only to books. Practical implementation of some is need of how otherwise execution of such programmes and events in future is not possible on behalf of visiting officers.
