

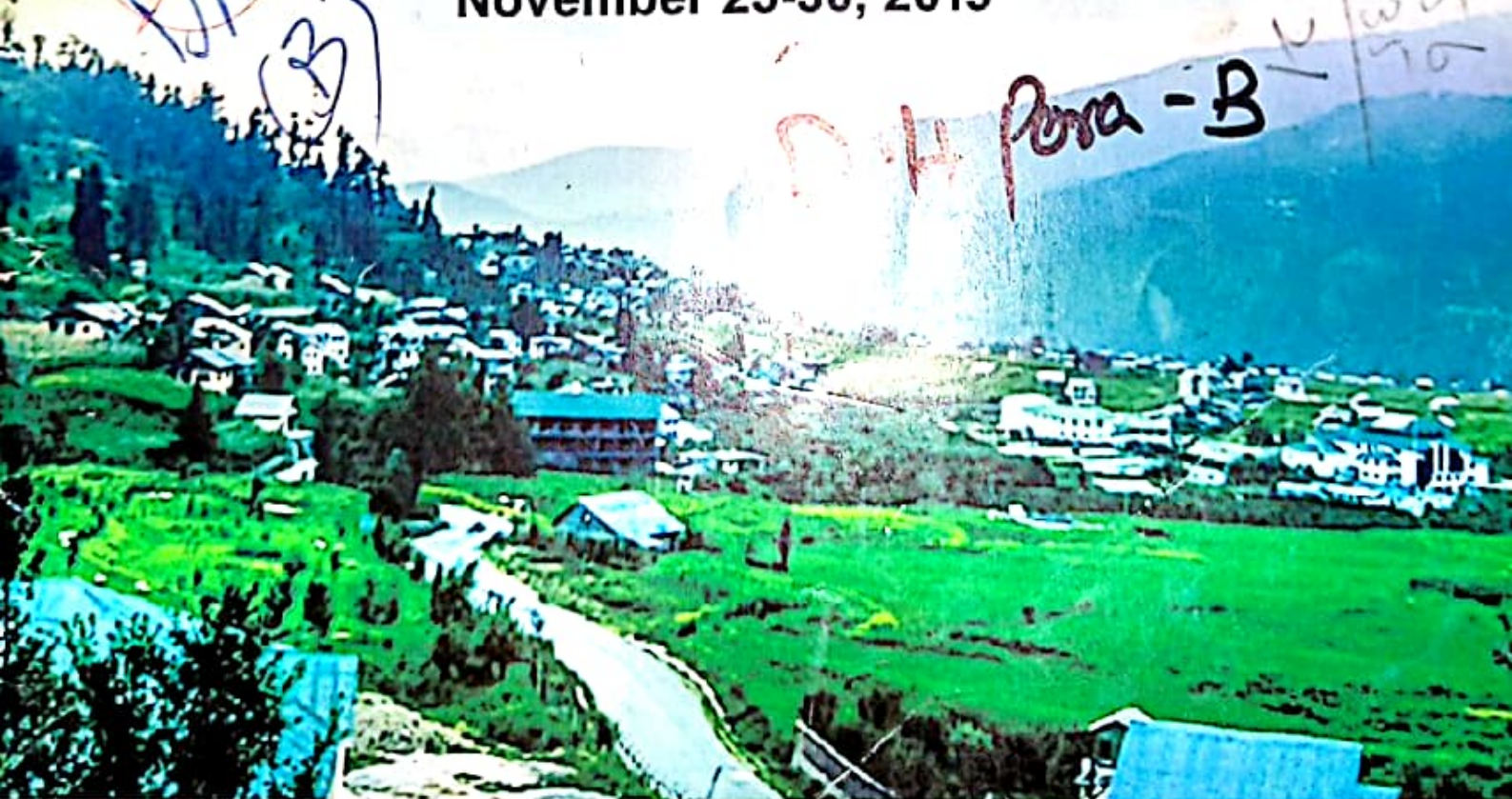

The administrative officers are working with zeal and need to be encouraged as well in addition to improving the service delivery vis-a-vis release of funds to the departments without delay.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

(the visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

The general public want redressal of grievances at a faster rate with the impediments being done away with better coordination, along ^{financial} departmental lines. The enthusiasm generated among rural masses by officers coming to their doorsteps is great but is fizzled out as soon as the officer is not able to make a commitment regarding development, on behalf of the govt.

The U/sd is of the opinion that the visiting officer should be empowered to take some small decisions on the spot & be provided with a small amount of fund towards the same. The monitoring of this expenditure be done in the program itself by the public itself.
