	During B2V2 it was observed that the people of the area are optimistic about the development. Some of the demands put before me are small but very important for the people of the area, if these demands are timely addressed by the govt. it is going to strengthen their faith in the working of the govt. Various departments are

working in the area but the work of RDDs is commendable as majority of developmental work is carried out by this department. GRPs are working nicely and with great zeal and dedication, but it was felt they are not satisfied with the remuneration they are getting.

People of the panchayat are particular about basic facilities like Education, Healthcare, Safe drinking water, good roads etc.

It was observed that in Gram Sabha, different dept's were represented by low rank officials and it was difficult for them to provide data about different schemes of their departments. It is strongly suggested to frame a tour
