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L) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

1. Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):

- Maintenance of new road from Kachanval to Jai Goliapra under PMDSY. The road is in dilapidated condition.
- Provision of LT/HT poles & wiring infrastructure which has already been approved under BTPS works.
- Demand for completion of NTPC building - work has been halted for some time, which needs to be resumed urgently by BICOP.
- There are no. of prospective applicants to be included under PMDSY. So far 99 applicants have been included & govt. has not yet started construction of the houses. Further, there is also lack of electricity in most of the villages. We started in carrying out some manual works, many used incentivized govt. program & under the govt. this will be a fruitful environment.

2. Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:

1. Demand for fast track completion of NTPC building by BICOP.
2. Maintenance of new road from Kachanval to Jai Goliapra by PMDSY.

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III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

Overall perception of functioning has picked up space since the 1st programme of BTV, & people are now responsive in raising their demands & requirements & are now enthusiastic to participate in Gram Sabha's giving inputs in formulation of GPDP.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

The village panchayat Ari-Goripora needs immediate attention in providing of basic facilities like:-

1. Requirement of doctor at PHC for all working days. At present, doctor attends for only 2-3 days.
 2. Prospective beneficiaries under schemes like ANAY, PM Kisan, etc. need to be taken up.
- Overall the urgent public requirements as mentioned in the work book need to be prioritized in the annual GPDP of the panchayat.
