Most of the frontline workers of various department are rendering their services up to the satisfaction of general public except Hort Dept and PDD which are not visiting the PRT due to shortage of staff. PRI members are also very Cooperative and responsive.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

Events of visit under B2V-2 prgm. were organized by Liaison officer in coordination with PRI members as per fixed schedule in congenial atmosphere. PRI members are aware of public problems but needs more awareness about Govt schemes and also require to undergo regular trngs for capacity building. PRT needs staff like Accountant for operation of schemes like MDA/PMSS/mulitition etc. Response and enthusiasm of the general public was low in B2V-2 as compared to B2V-1 due to non redressal of some issues.

B2V programs should be organized at the most once in a year and that too after completion of full financial year.
