4. Construction of Sub Centre at Kherd in Pyp. Salal Kote.
5. Construction of Play Ground at Salal Songli Dali. Work in progress. Some additional funds required.
6. Upgradation of Middle School Pouneli and road from Bus stand Pouneli to M-School.
7. Construction of Guest House near Play Ground - Salal Kote.

II Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:

The major problem brought in the notice of us is of Pyp which I have personally inspected in the area of Pouneli ward 6. of Pyp Salal Kote. Even in 20th Century people are still trying for drinking water facilities. There are about 300 people who are facing this problem. It is really a heart touching and very very genuine problem which needs to be addressed by Dist. Admin on priority basis.

III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

The Functioning of the Govt is Quite o.k. as at Present Govt is trying at its best level to reach to Gross root level in addressing the demands of the masses. Secondly, with Implementation of online system, all the benefits in the shape of pay dues, Pension etc are being directly credited in people's accounts. Three line system introduced is also a welcome step of the Govt through which lot of the people has improved at Gross root level.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

The site of Pvt visited i.e. Sahel Kote is Hilly one. Main demands of the people are relating to Power supply, Drinking water facilities. There are certain areas especially ward no 6.
