

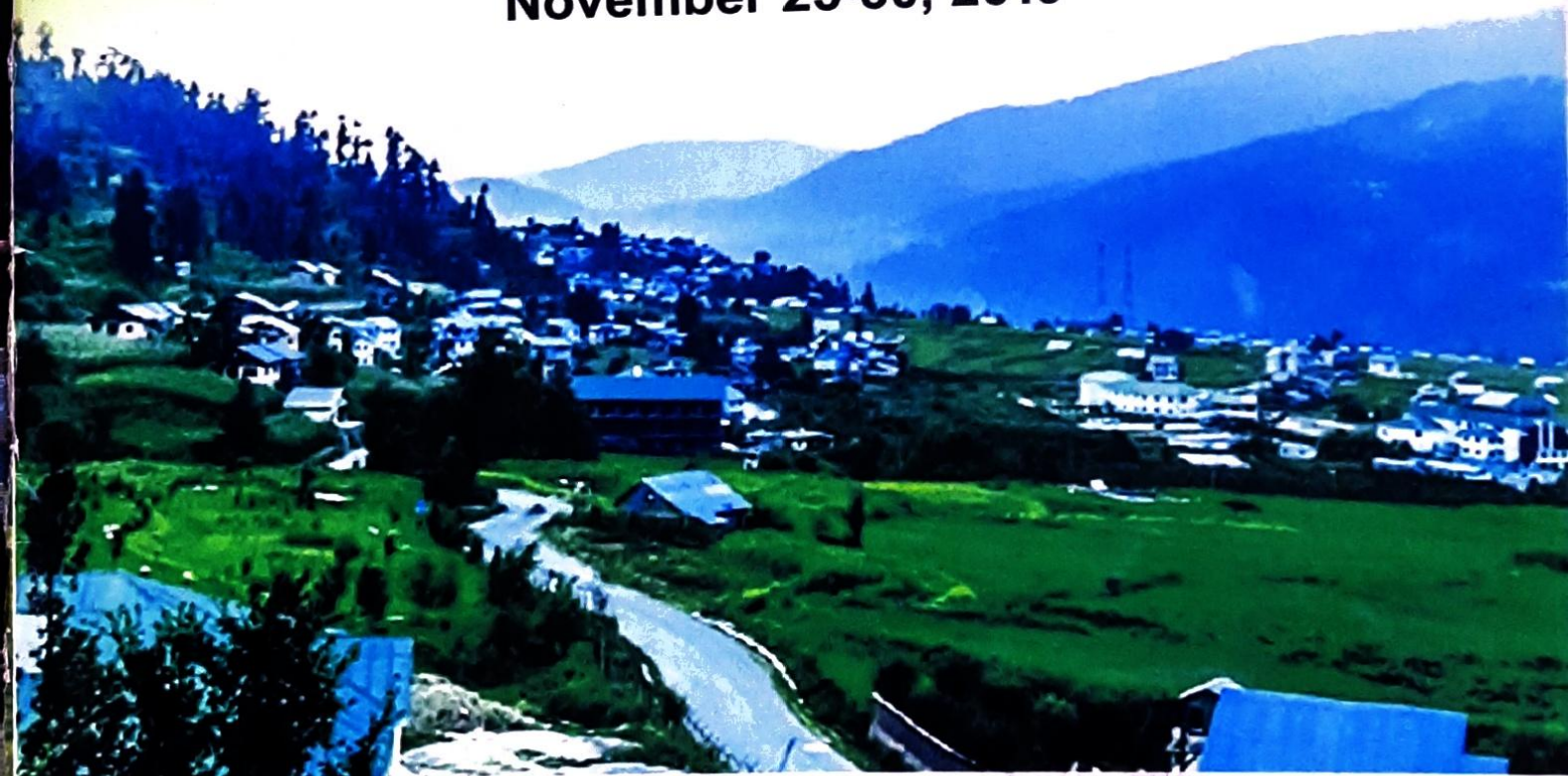

L) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I	Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):
1.	Road from Dode to Shant in very bad condition Turning Point also demanded at the road.
2.	New Link Road Bagla to Dod Dudhwa 5 km.
3.	6 No. Transformers for 6 wards demanded. Electric Poles approx 200 nos.
4.	Health Centre at village Khunu Bhatbaji Demanded
5.	Bagla to Dal Daman Road. Total Length 10 km out of which 5 km completed.
6.	Khulu Bagla Road total length 8 km out of which 1 km completed.
7.	Bagla Panchayat to be divided into two (or) Panchayats as too much area voter wise. (1) Bagla (2) Khunu Bhatbaji
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
	Lack of Patwari Only one no. Lineman Bank Protection to the Houses / Land being exposed during constructing Shant Bagla Road by PMGSY

III	Overall perception of functioning of the government:
	all the depart ments are functioning to the satisfaction of the public (as per the public) but no work on ground saying shortage of also availability of funds.
IV	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (the visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)
	Very poor response by the public to this B2V2 Programme only 20 No. villagers attended Gram Sabha. They are demanding the works already demanded are still pending. Only suggestion is that the condition of the Panchayat is very bad (due to Road Network, drinking water) which needs to be improved for the betterment of the villagers.
