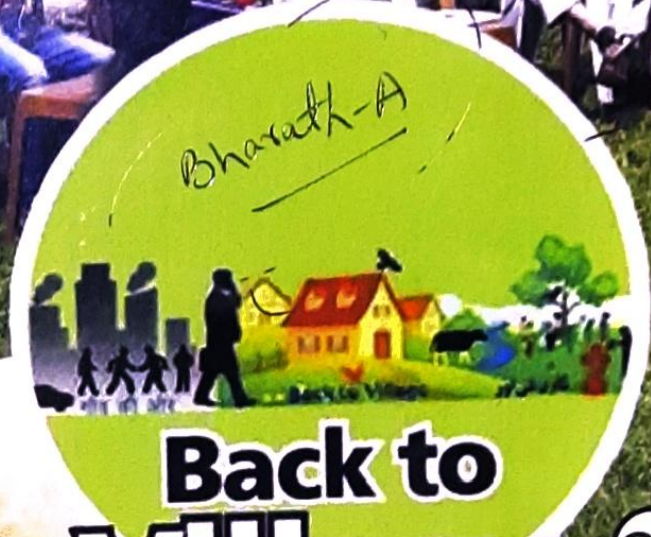




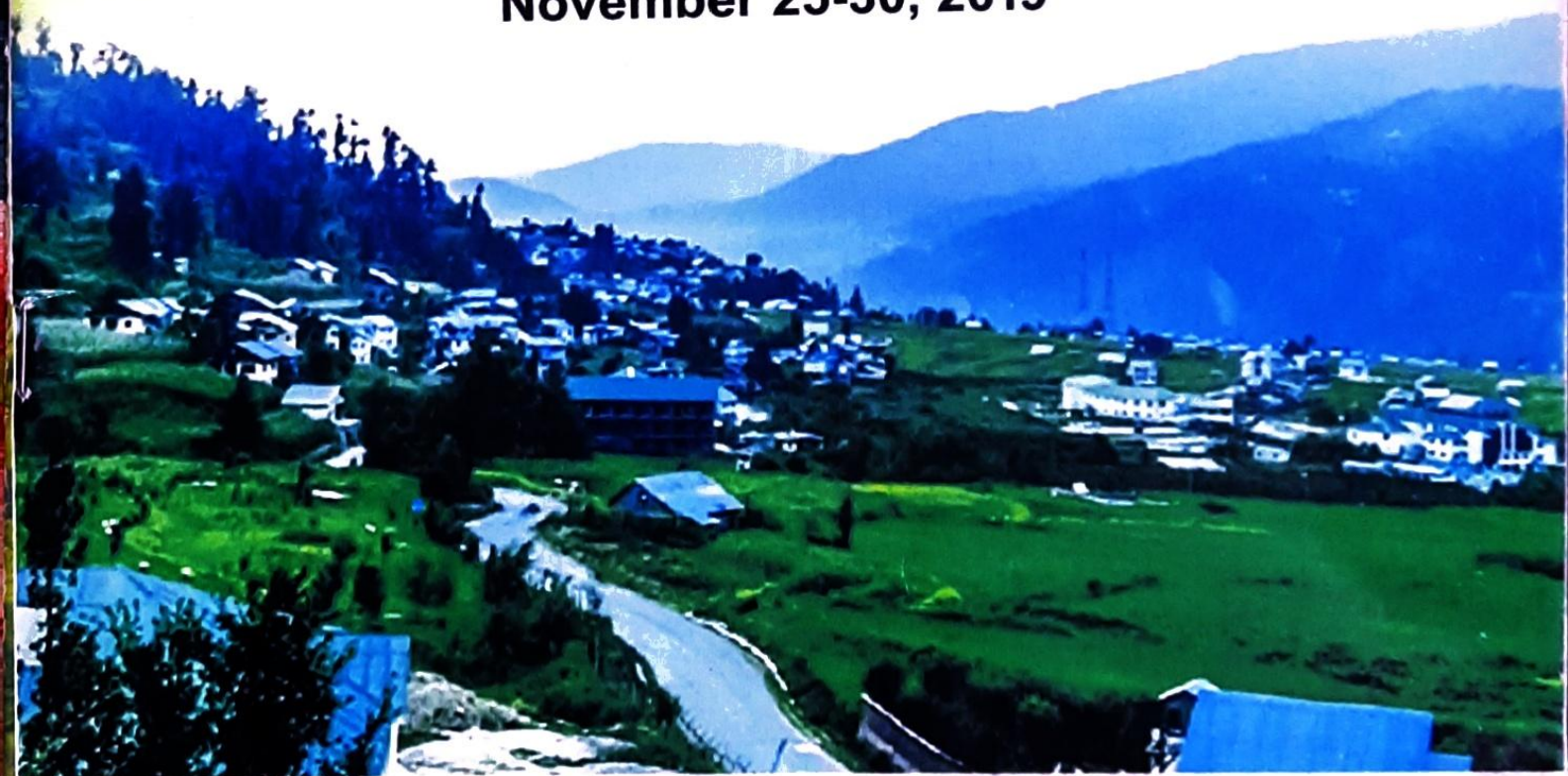

L) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I	Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):
	The works of P.H.E Dept. is most important. In fact the 1. Infrastructure is in worst state - Gravity Line of Distribution Line needs to be installed urgently. All household connections had repairs. 2. Road from km 11 to Bharat needs to be tarred urgently. People complained that tenders were done in 2011 and works have not been done yet. Now in this season the work is being done which would last. 3. A Recharging Station in Bharath and a Mini-Hydel Project at Dori. 4. People demand Solar Lights on the pattern of Ladakh and Manuval as during winter they remain cut-off from electricity. 5. People demanded that the Taluk Office of Bharat Bagh Tehsil should be in Bharath and not Dali. where it is functioning right now. 6. A Community Hall and an Ambulance for P.H.C. 7. All the Schools in the Panchayat need a thorough infrastructure improvement and repairs and also protection against damage by some miscreants.
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
	The Staff of the Schools of this Panchayat which has been attached at some other place should be brought back to their schools for their proper functioning. People complained that the staff which is posted here in schools is attached at other places and in some schools the teachers are less qualified than their subordinates.

III	Overall perception of functioning of the government:
	People initially were apathetic and indifferent to B2V2. It took a good deal of effort to convince them. They feel that the Commitment, done to them are never fulfilled. Unfortunately, no positive sign was received. There was disgust in them w.r.t. the availability of Public Goods especially Roads.
IV	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:
	(the visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)
	I have observed that people will offer their full Co-operation and Support if the works are done in a manner which benefit them in the long term as the quality of works done is poor and lasts for a season or a more. Roads and P.H.U. (tapped water in households) is the biggest issue. Every person complained about these two sectors.

There was a cry for developing Tourism in the area, as the area has immense potential for Tourism and the first need for that is a good road network.
