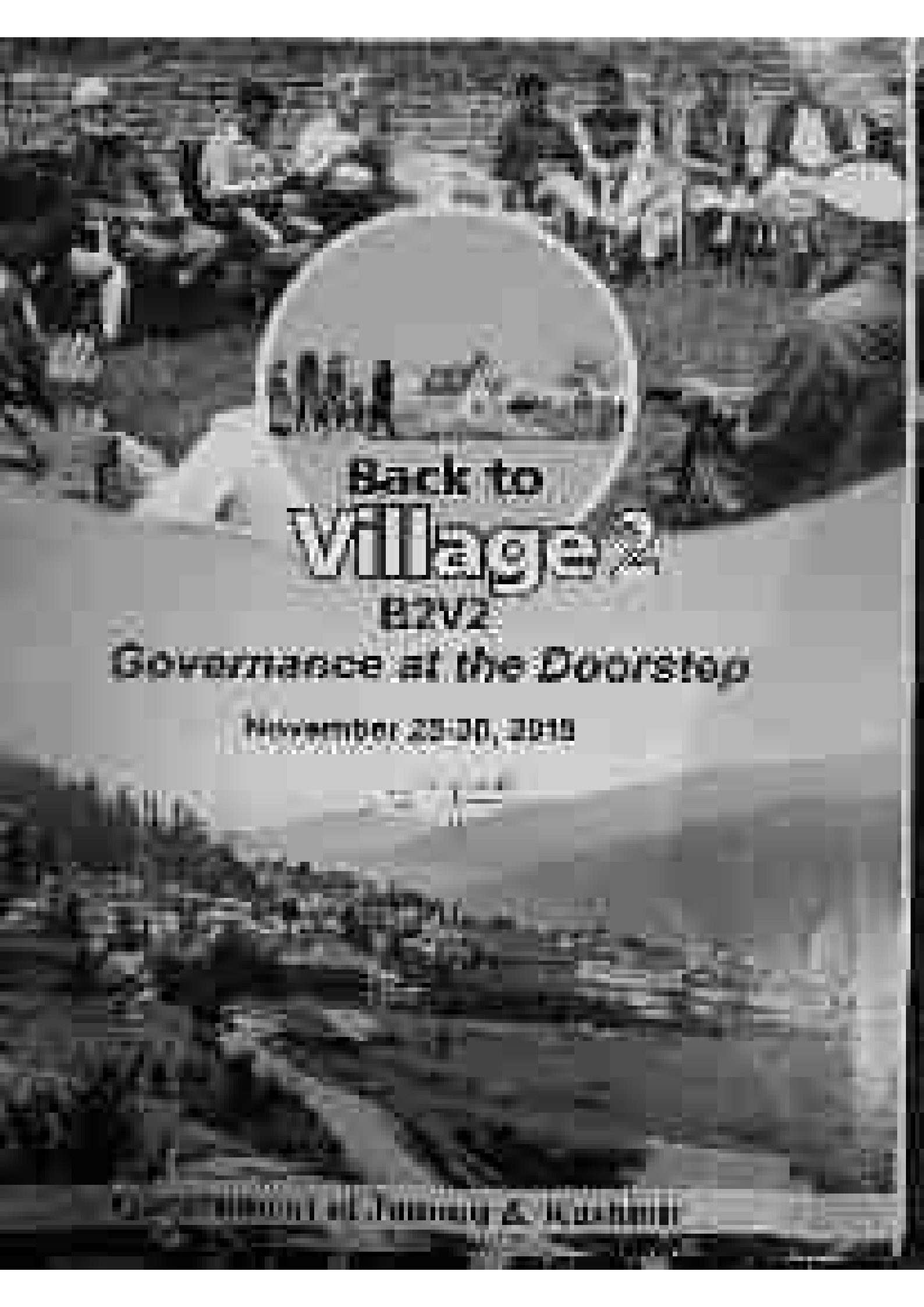




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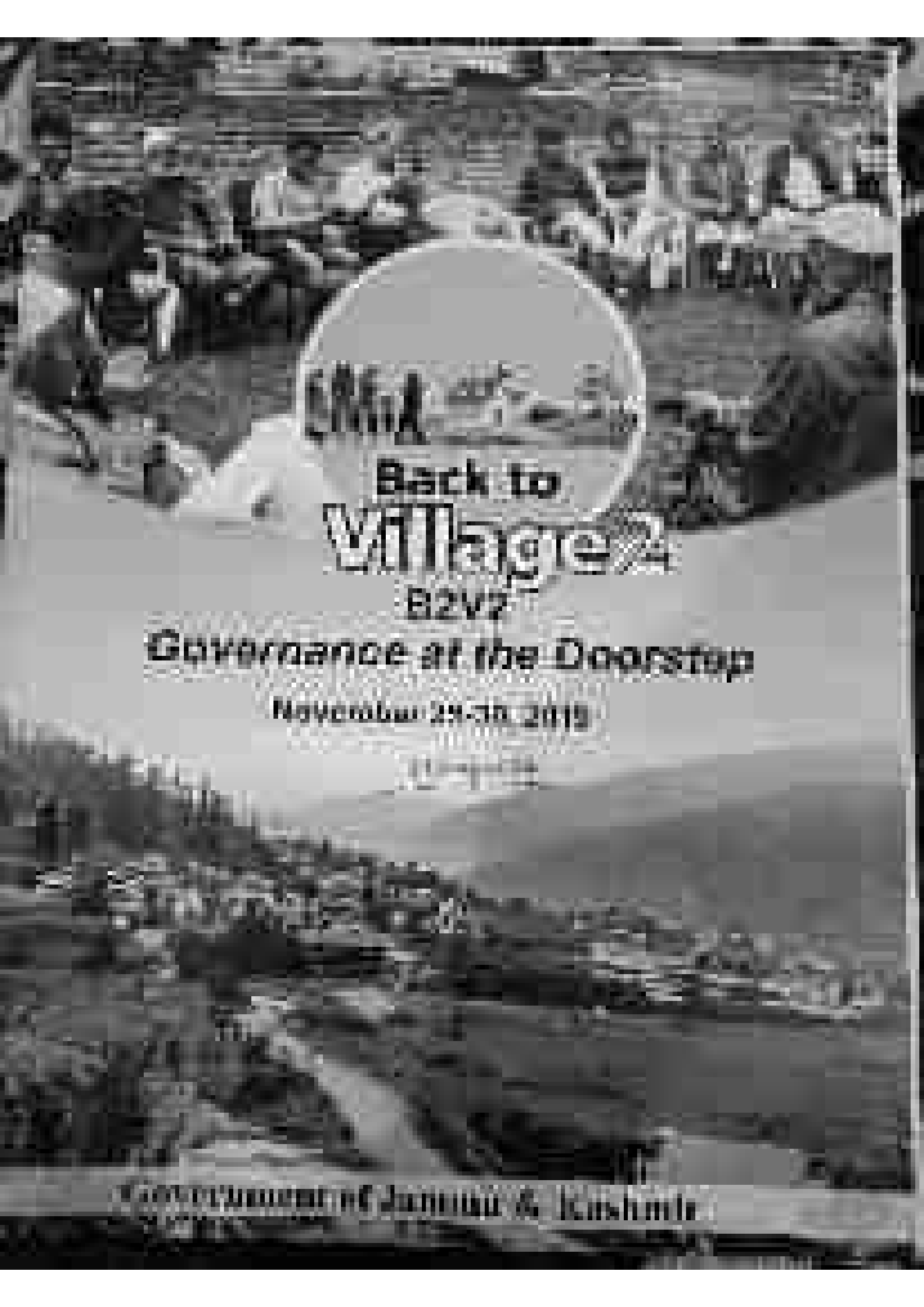

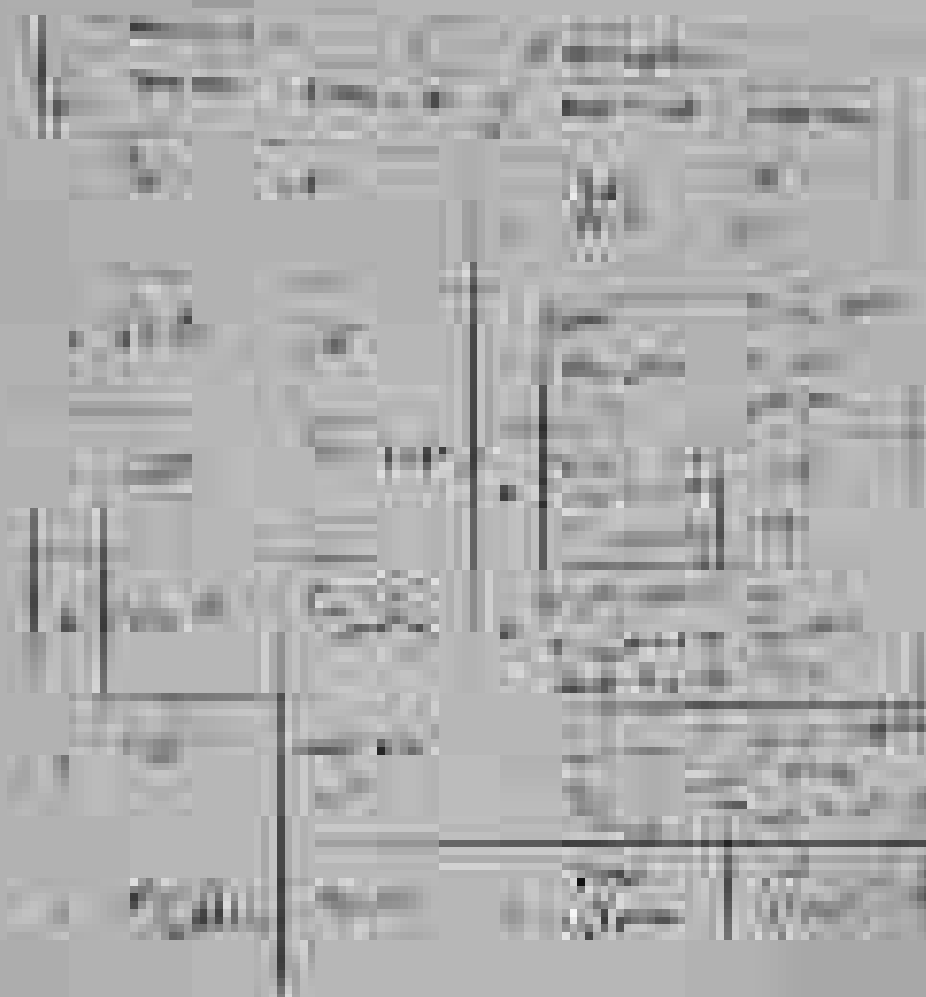

The following table shows the results of the regression analysis for the dependent variable *Perceived Organizational Support*. The independent variables are *Organizational Commitment* and *Organizational Identification*. 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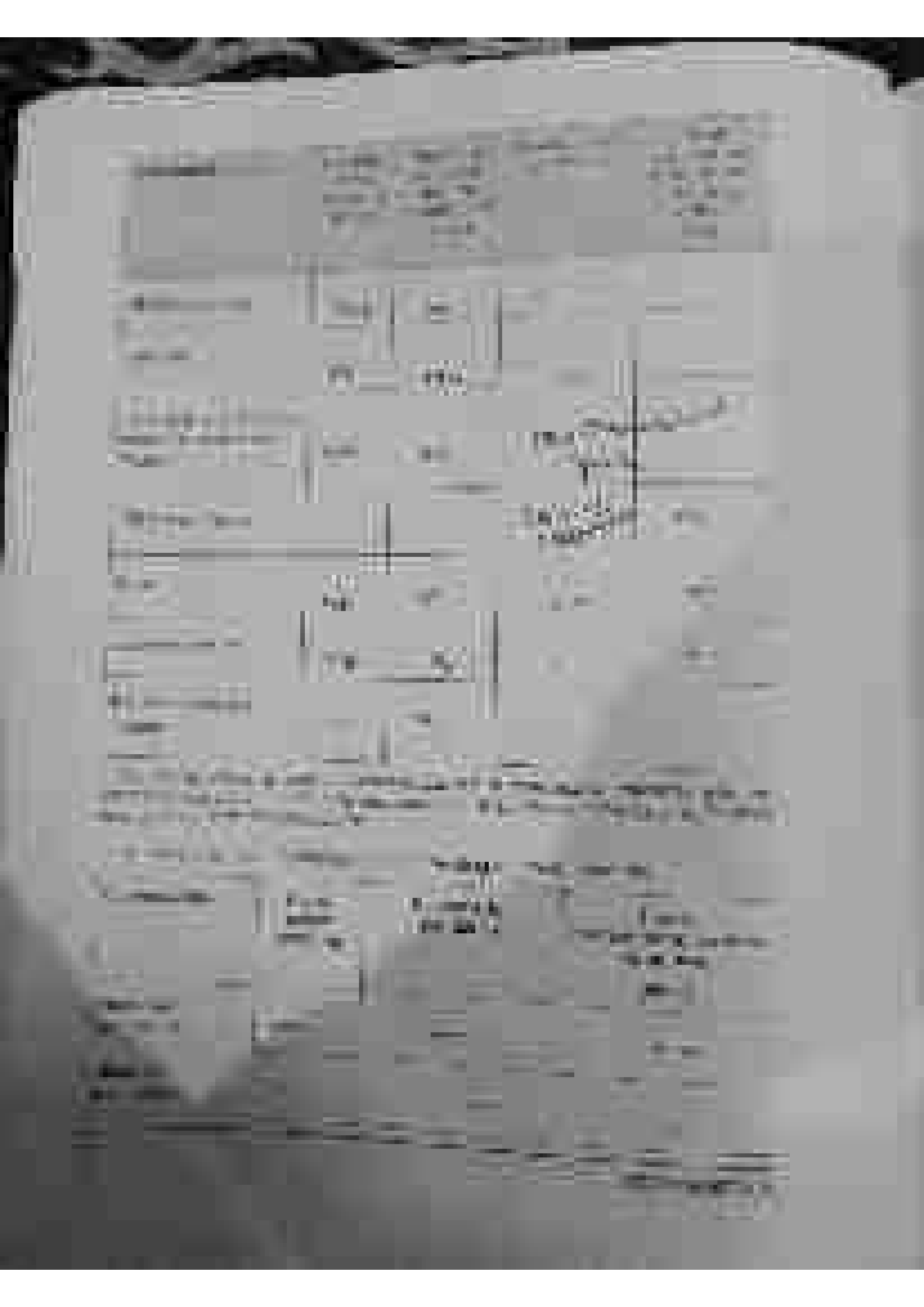
