



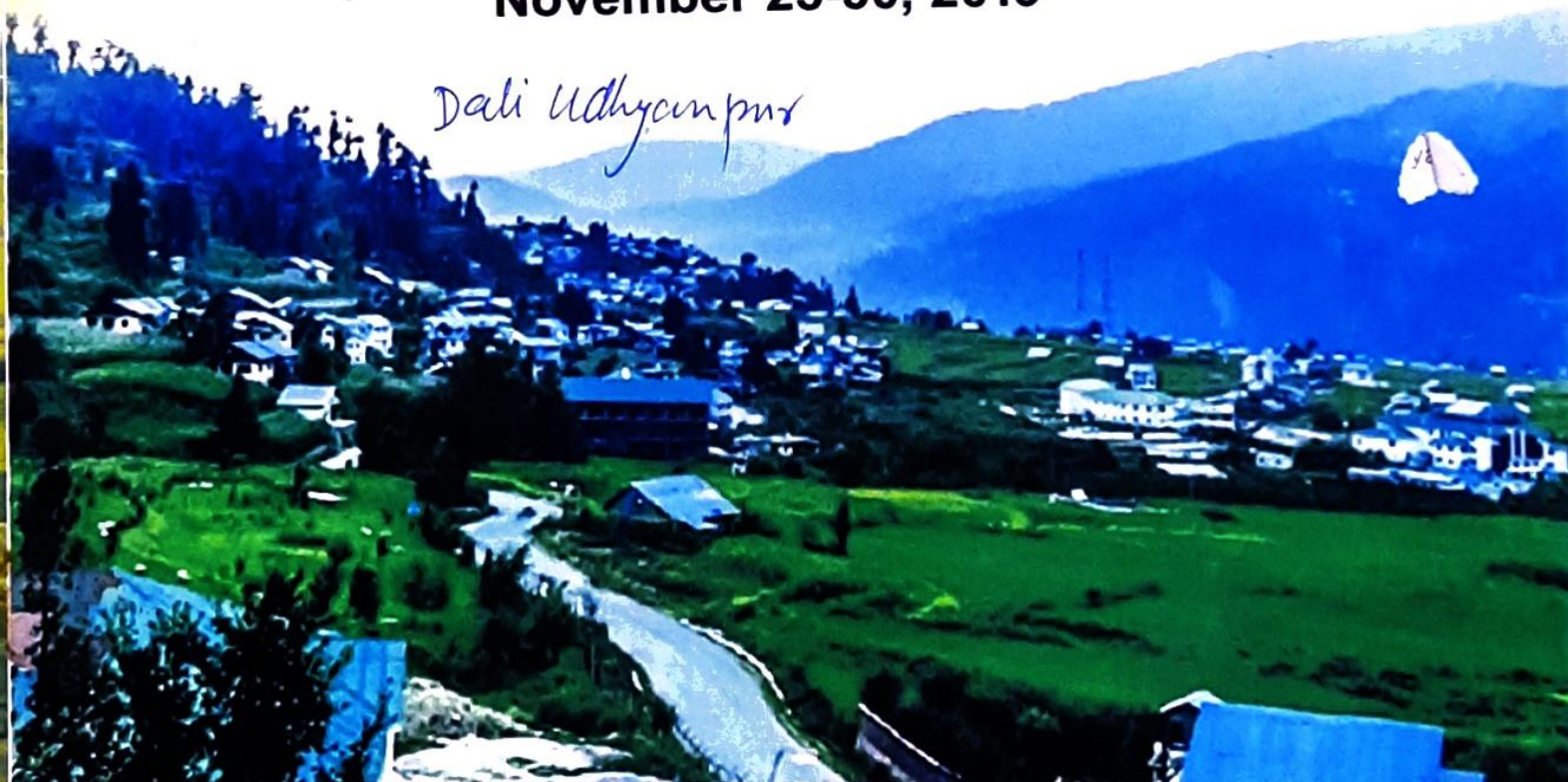

3.	Construction of Primary school building at Dohri Barua.
4.	New Dispensary Centre should be given at Dudhwa X Barua.
5.	A Urgent need of 3 Electric transformers, 180 poles and 25 km wire.
6.	Construction of Community hall at Barua X Dudhwa.
7.	Receiving Power station at Dohri.
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
-	Anganwari Centres are not functioning in the area properly.
-	Shortage of Staff in Revenue and education department.
-	Ration shops are at long distance X people are facing lot of difficulty.

III	Overall perception of functioning of the government:
	The government is doing good job by providing doorstep governance programmes, faster services and development. The government is trying its best to energise and empower Panchayati raj institution.
