The data set consists of 1,000 observations. The variables are defined as follows: Age is the respondent's age in years; Gender is a binary variable indicating the respondent's sex; Education is the respondent's highest level of education in years; Income is the respondent's annual household income in dollars; Health is a binary variable indicating the respondent's self-reported health status; Marital Status is a binary variable indicating the respondent's marital status; Religion is a binary variable indicating the respondent's religious affiliation; Political Affiliation is a binary variable indicating the respondent's political party affiliation; Employment is a binary variable indicating the respondent's employment status; Home Ownership is a binary variable indicating the respondent's home ownership status; Vehicle Ownership is a binary variable indicating the respondent's vehicle ownership status; Travel Frequency is the number of times the respondent travels per year; Travel Distance is the total distance traveled in miles; Travel Cost is the total cost of travel in dollars; Travel Satisfaction is the respondent's satisfaction with travel on a scale of 1 to 5. The control variables are included to account for the potential confounding effects of travel frequency, distance, cost, and satisfaction on the dependent variable.

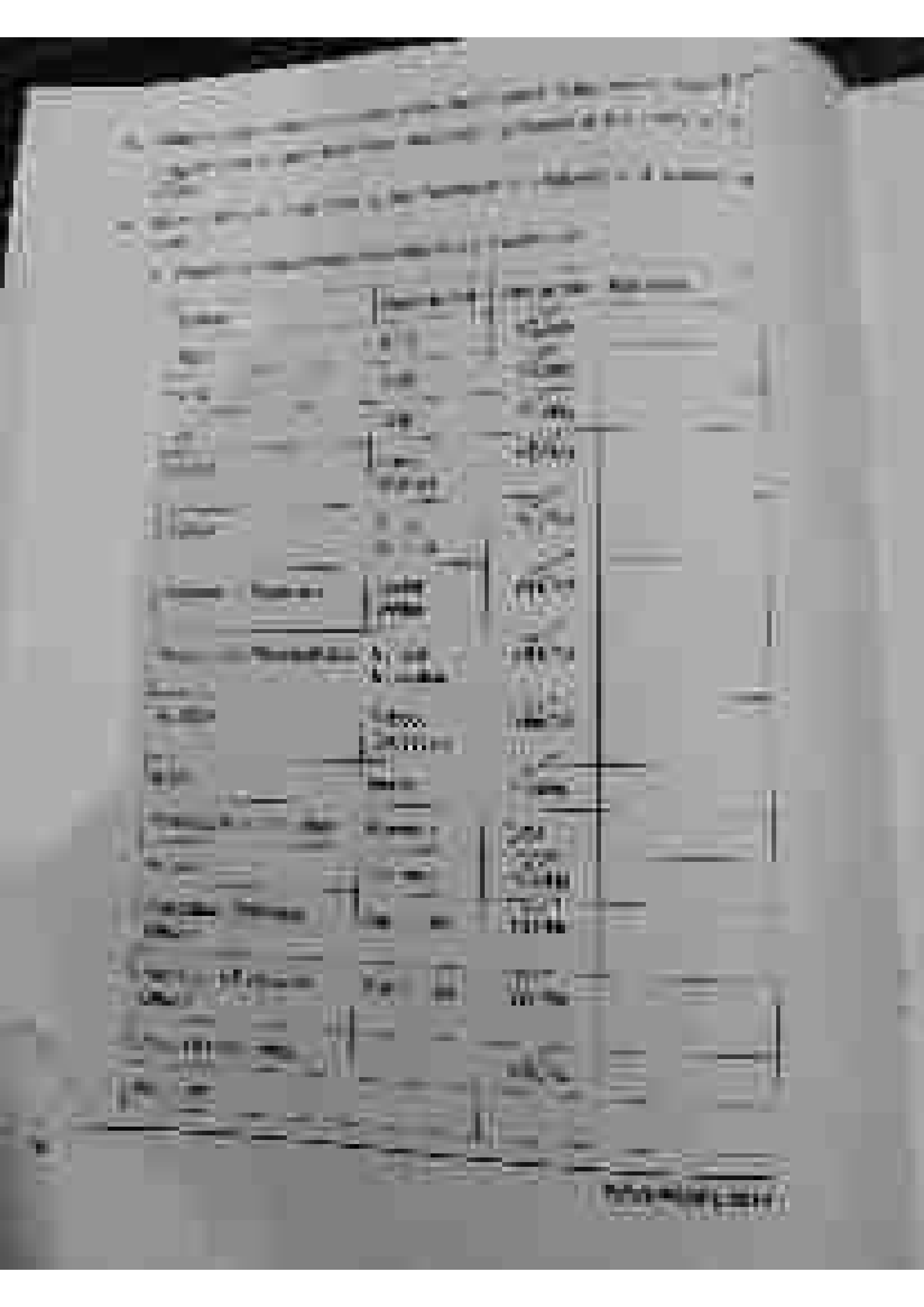

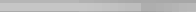
