- 3. Vermi-compost beds, Pack Houses, Agri. machinery, weed mini-tractors, tool-kits, Nets for HY crops/fruits, irrigation water-pumps should be made available at larger quantities to cultivators/farmers and at subsidised rates/loan facilities.
