As verified from Railway registers, this approach from the line dept. will seriously hamper the functionality of GP and prevent it from playing its due Constitutional role.

III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

→ For Gp to emerge as the model governing body for village development, it is important to increase its skill footprint. This will boost its confidence and assertiveness in face of hard headed bureaucratic dominance. The functioning of line dept. needs to be further brought under complete control of Gp.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

(the visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

- ① The visits Under B2V2-2 has enthused the village panchayat and made it aware about its constitutional mandate. However, for it to play its role the bureaucratic inertia and lack of deference towards Gp needs to be removed and checked.
- ② The frontline government functionaries need to be sensitised for the complimentary role they need to play in deference to the newly constituted local bodies.
