

- IV Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max 1/1):
1. Road Condition of hamlets are dilapidated need immediate metalling and black topping. Allah to Kothay Massey, Allah to Kothay Massey and Allah to Kothay Massey roads need ~~priority~~ immediate repair, metalling and black topping before onset of Monsoon.
  2. Since irrigation facilities and availability of irrigation water is insufficient, 3 NOS of Tube well for irrigation are also urgently required.
  3. Ambulance is urgently required for Panchayat, since no public transport is available in area.
  4. PHC: Already existing Sub centre maybe upgraded and fresh staff is required, only Doctors with pharmaceutical staff required.
  5. Networking of water pipes connecting to village Kothay Massey and Kothay Massey urgently required.
  6. Degree College either in Panchayat Allah or at Arni and Nabet at Allah.
  7. 05 transformers - 2 for Allah and one each for other hamlets to get rid of low voltage.

V Any major complaint brought to notice:

About 103 farmers are not getting compensation on account of their land occupied by defence forces, since 2013. Moreover the people are suffering a lot in cultivation of their crops beyond defence area and even not got any compensation whose land have been occupied by Army/defence forces.

VI Overall assessment of visit (Public Services): Please mention best practices, if any, observed

Impact of public services were seen only in village Allah whereas their reach to other hamlets are just negligible. Nothing best, except newly created infrastructure by RDD departments and Block office officiating at Panchayat itself.
