

L) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I	Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):
1.	Completion of Doul-Mugam WSS (2010) to remove drinking-water scarcity.
2.	Rented Hr. Sec school playground to acquisition be speeded-up & the upgraded school be physically upgraded with infrastructure. (Fencing)
3.	Irrigation facilities be augmented. & Daahgam & Reshi Khul be restored & recharged and plugging of leaking in its floor.
4.	Health, Sheep & vety Centres be opened-up immediately in the GP.
5.	Laying of Conductor line & establishment of Sub-station at Darool-ul-Darani (under construction) New Colony & Street lighting.
6.	Completion of under-construction Panchayat-Ghar along with basic facilities and Perimeter wall.
7.	Establishing Tehsil HQ Aloosa at some central point having easy access to all panchayats.
8.	ATM (JKB) be established alongwith USB.
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer. • R & B dept during finalising its plan should incorporate the inputs of stakeholders. • Direct Connectivity to Bpr-Sopore Road. missing. • Non-availability of Potable water to households & that of Electricity. • Basic Health - Care facilities missing both to human & livestock. • Lack of.
