



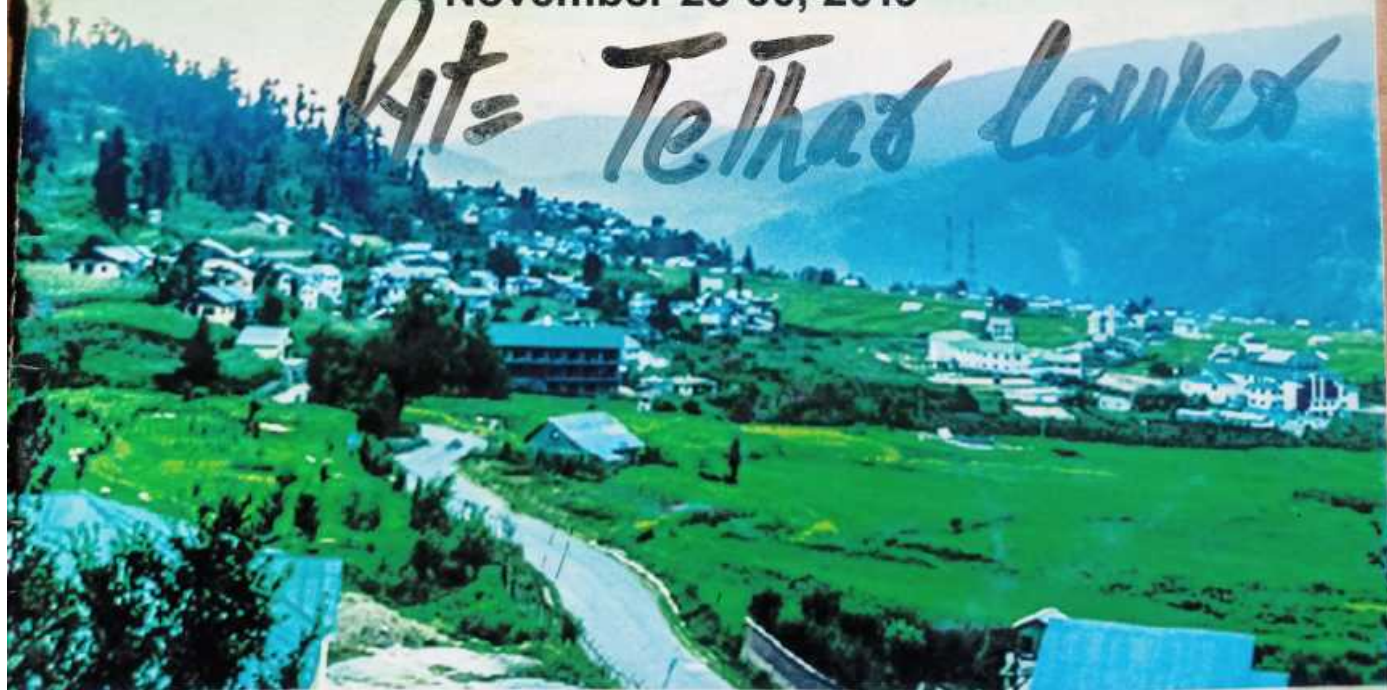

Water supply (drinking), power supply, Panchayat GHs not well maintained, no gas cylinder for cooking purposes available in Anganwadi centres, No street lights, HS school Tethar in bad shape.

III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

The people in Panchayat are illiterate and are not enthusiastic about functioning of government. The delivery of Public Services is very poor.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

(the visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

The delivery of Public Services is very poor in Panchayat and departments like PHE, PDS should be made answerable so that problems of people are resolved earnestly. MGNREGA staff is very poor, hardworking and need to be absorbed permanently in department.
