1.	No compensation awarded against loss of cultivated land due to shifting of course by river Chenab.
2.	Longer spans of both HT/LT network of PDD. Shifting/Re-positioning of 63 KVA S/stn at CK Pura (Machine Pura). Posing safety threat to people.
3.	No works has been taken up during B2V1.
4.	Delay in grant of Old age Pension. No Cards issued to Genuine BPL under Ayushman Bharat.
