From the 2nd visit, it has been observed that Back to Village Programme has remained quite successful & at the same time it has raised expectations of the village population many of their demands will be fulfilled after ascertaining the immediate need by visiting officers.

In this connection sufficient funds need to be placed at the disposal of Dist.
