

I) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:
①	There are so many demands but the pressing one is shifting of middle school in the building of High school and High school be shifted in the newly constructed HSS complex at Nagbal.
②	PHC needs upgradation. There is little space, it is hugely congested in a single story building. The ambulance service be kept available.
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:
①	The widening of road from Ladoora chowk to Kanispora is constant and pressing demand of the Village.
②	The people also want sharing of electricity from Nagbal Grid station.
③	A powerful Generator for (OHT) at Nagbal. ↓ Overhead Tank
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)
	Though the response was cold in B2V3 initially but after some persuasion and interaction by the field officials, people came up with some serious complaints. Hospital is very congested & needs some more space (building). Ambulance service & night shift of doctors is also required. Besides the village Ladoora is large in terms of size & pop. (Approx. 10,000 souls) So I would strongly recommend a trifurcation of the road at Nagbal. 9/1/20 Pandharpur
