8	The water pipes carrying potable water have corroded & have leakage at several places, further filtration plant is non-functional. This issue should be addressed at an earliest.
9	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer.

The PDD Department has erected the LT lines over trees, on temporary wooden poles. There is a severe dearth of electric poles, further the electric wires are of State wires. The issue is of severe concern, particularly during winters. The things turn all the more worse. The wires should be erected on poles.



III Overall perception of functioning of the government:
