L) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I	Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):
1.	Const. of drain in W.no.3 as the entire locality drain water is coming & getting dumped due to no exit thereby causing great loss to the nearby fields
2.	Upgradation of Govt High Sch. Dampur to Higher Sec. School on priority basis. Also there is need to sanction mini-stadium in the Panchayat
3.	Const. of bridge over Canal in Badayla chak area (bridge already declared unsafe) & Road leading to Maghalaya. Approx. length (1.5 km)
4.	Const. of Road from main road to Mohalla Lal Chaud, Shingling has been done 17 yrs back. Metalling & B.T. is required to be done. Length 1.5 km approx
5.	A new Scheme for left irrigation is required to be given to the Panchayat as Nud Phox-2 is only to irrigate the left out area of approx. 1500 kanals of area
6.	Const. of Community Hall at Badayla chak in W.no. 9, (Land is available)
7.	Const. of Parks from New Basti bridge to Dampur bus stand to create Recreational avenue
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
1.	Encroachment on the state land.
2.	Encroachment on the irrigation land along the Canal leading to Dampur Panchayat.

III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

Due to lack of co-ordination among various Govt. departments the overall perception of functioning of Govt is not upto the mark as it should have to be.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

1. There is strong need to have co-ordination among various Govt. departments to make the public delivery system more effective & result oriented.
2. B2V programme is very noble thought & a very well conceived but should be organised along with a complete team of officers from different deptt who can give on the spot results & may be organised in the govt. block wise at different dates Panchayat wise instead.
3. A Comprehensive Panchayat wise programme of all the deptts should be framed instead of doing works in piecemeal.
4. A proper feedback system should be kept in place at all levels.
5. A team of dedicated officers should be engaged to accomplish noble cause.
