I	Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):
1.	upgradation of Sub-Center to PUC, its demarcation and fencing. Requirement of Ambulance + doctor at Sub-Center
2.	Residents of Sampurn Nadihal need protection from land-slide by nearby Hill.
3.	More need of PUE upgradation for water supply to house holds of Sampurn, Shoh MZelle + other areas of Nadihal - A
4.	Construction of Drainage + Macadamisation of main road and link roads need to be done on priority as the same is in dilapidated condition
5.	Cargut, Sorani, Anni Stapple Craft Centre need to be shifted from Ladokra to Nadihal for economic interests of locals as Ladokra has two bank loans, at present
6.	People are demanding for Co-Operative shop for Nadihal - A
7.	Sanction of Road from Nadihal to Indrapur like to road via sub-station construction of Panbayanal Ghos
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
	Electricity, roads and water schemes upgradation

III	Overall perception of functioning of the government:
	People have mixed response about functioning of government, overall it is satisfactory.
IV	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (the visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)
	The B2V program is going good for assessment of developmental works, but these programs need to be scheduled after feedback from Parliament's whether the previous requirements have been addressed or not.
