The visiting officer visited every nook & corner of the Panchayat & interacted with general public. The people have appreciated the concept of B2V programme. But there is general public dissent about the non-fulfilment of demands raised by public in B2V. There is no adequate allocation of funds for various public demands raised by public in B2V. There should be timely & adequate allocation of funds & immediate redressal of public demands.
