



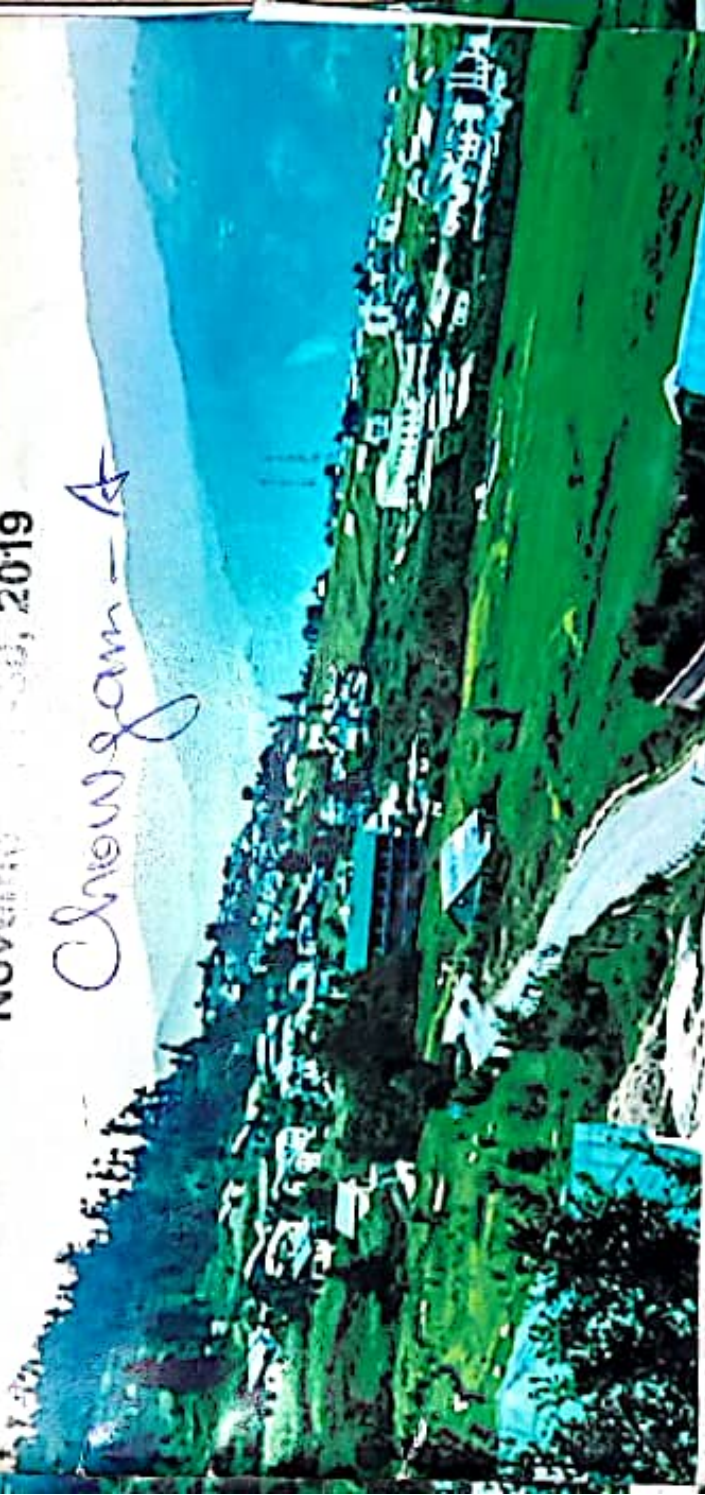

II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
01	Despite consistent reminders, Irrigation Dept. completely failed in restoring the defunct "Dusse Lathi" the primary source of irrigation for the Panchayat.
02	The Panchayat vehemently claimed the status of PBA and argued that the surrounding villages like Bineel, Lamer, Bagairad, Sapt and Wargad are already availing the benefit of PBA status.

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III	Overall perception of functioning of the government:	There appeared a vacuum between the govt. and the public. Grievances are increasing at a faster pace and don't get redressed commensurately. Noteworthy to mention, people have become sceptical towards the government due to non-fulfilment of demands projected during Back to Village - Phase I.
IV	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (the visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)	On the basis of responses, grievances and demands projected by both the public and govt. functionaries, it is suggested that necessary infrastructure and staff may be facilitated in different govt. offices so that their health and richness is improved for the overall satisfaction of the people in the Panchayat.
