III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

The people of Gram Panchayat (GP) have great expectations from Government. But during interaction with general public of Gram Panchayat, they are not satisfied with functioning of government, as no development has occurred in Gram Panchayat since decades. The people of Panchayat Halga are living a miserable life without basic amenities like road, electricity, Health centers, drinking water facilities, Electric Transformers/poles & wires. No work has started on languishing road projects of PMGSY/R&B and construction of health center. The functioning of the Govt. has also come under the scanner due to delay in payment of under PMAY, and insufficient number of Health centers, ICDS centers etc.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

Good road connectivity and quality education is back bone for development of Panchayat Halga. Emphasis is required to be given for early completion of languishing road projects of PMGSY/R&B and completion of Health center. Macadamization of every road & const. of link roads/foot paths can mitigate the problems of people of Panchayat Halga. The Gram Panchayat Halga has been deprived of basic health facility and requires immediate const. of hospital building within shortest possible period of time. This is a pressing & genuine demand of Panchayat Halga. The school buildings have got damaged due heavy snow fall & some have developed cracks, which needs immediate attention of govt for safeguarding school children. There is need of construction of water reservoir/purification plants and repair & renovation of existing one. The people of Panchayat Halga is requesting for ICDS center/Handicrafts center/Sheep center/Ration Depot for overall development of Panchayat Halga. PDD sector needs improvement by functioning of more transformers, electric poles & wires.
