I) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:
1.	Lack of the proper water outlet to the existing irrigation channel creates water logging which creates problems for the orchardists the entire village into a cesspool.
2.	Lack of proper awareness & public outreach programs by the different govt departments to ensure the benefits reach the common ignorant masses regarding the different programs & schemes.
3.	Majority of the complaints & demands of B2V1 & B2V2 are still pending and need to be fulfilled immediately to provide relief to people.
II	Major urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:
1.	Cleaning & Desilting of the Irrigation Channel & removing the encroachments arding it to prevent waterlogging so that there is no inundation during rainy days & water flows freely.
2.	PHC, also demanded in B2V1 & B2V2, be established & land for the same be identified on the priority basis.
3.	Repair, maintenance & upgradation of poles & transmission line.
4.	Works on incomplete drainages & pending RCC Patter be completed.
5.	Quality infrastructure be provided in the school.
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)
	Back to village programme is a great initiative by the govt. It gives an opportunity to the people to put forth their issues, demands & problems before the govt so that the same can be resolved at the earliest. Having now now the experience of two back to village program viz; B2V1 & B2V2, I would say the enthusiasm level & people's participation was less this time than the earlier. The reason for this I think, is the non fulfillment of the ^{majority of} demands of the B2V1 & B2V2 programs. I would suggest the govt. to take the reports of the visiting officers seriously & work upon them at the earliest stage for the betterment & amelioration of the villagers . I would also like to say that the B2V3 program was held in the peak harvesting season when all the villagers were busy in paddy harvesting & able plucking, as a result they could not show up there presence in this program. Better if, to fix the proper timing for such programs in future, keeping in view the comfort & working schedule of the people living in rural areas. Thank you
