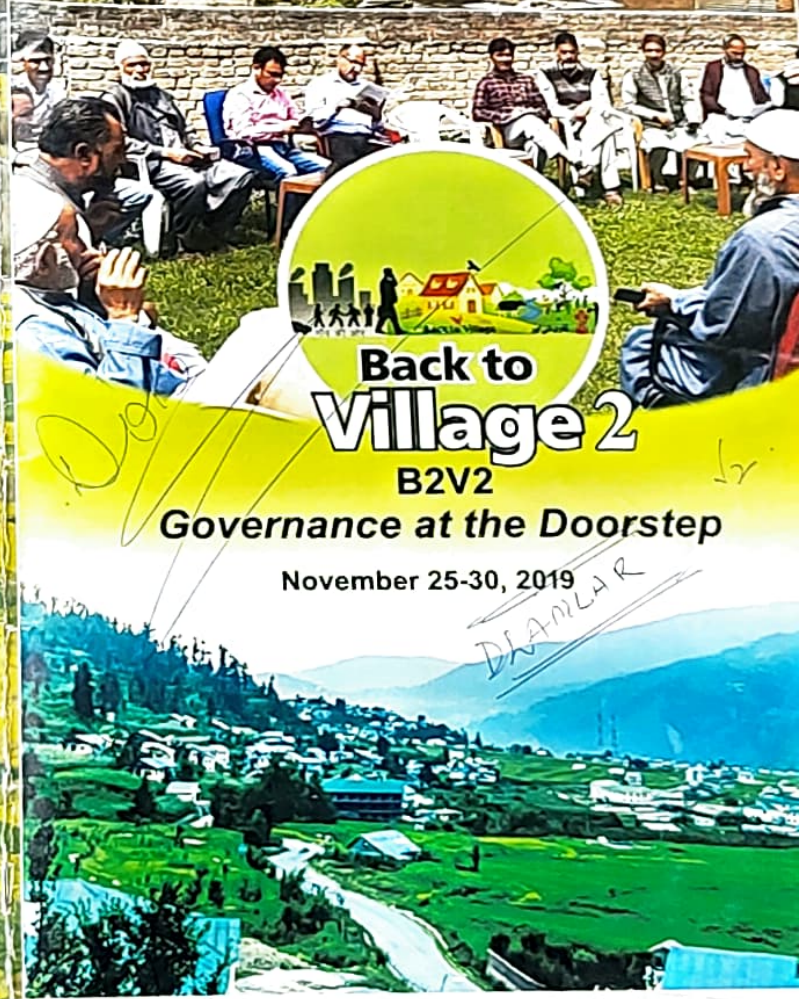

Functioning of govt department is not to the full satisfaction of Public due to lack of certain basic infrastructure in PR like PR house, health centre, bank, anganwadi works & demands identified during RSV, should be implemented on priority basis

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions

(The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in the report along with concrete suggestions)

Public has shown resentment for non execution of works & demands raised during RSV, Government should to execute the RSV, works.

- Suggestions:-
- More capacity building Training for PRI,
 - Frontline works of departments need to be undertaken
 - Need to generate awareness about schemes
 - Need for establishment of basic health centres, anganwadi/child care centres
 - Close monitoring of working and quality and feedback
 - Policy for regularization of adhoc/contract staff in order to develop a sense of security & dedication.
 - Institutionalisation of PRI by way of active participation of people in planning and development activities
 - Availability of adequate funds for timely execution of works.
