



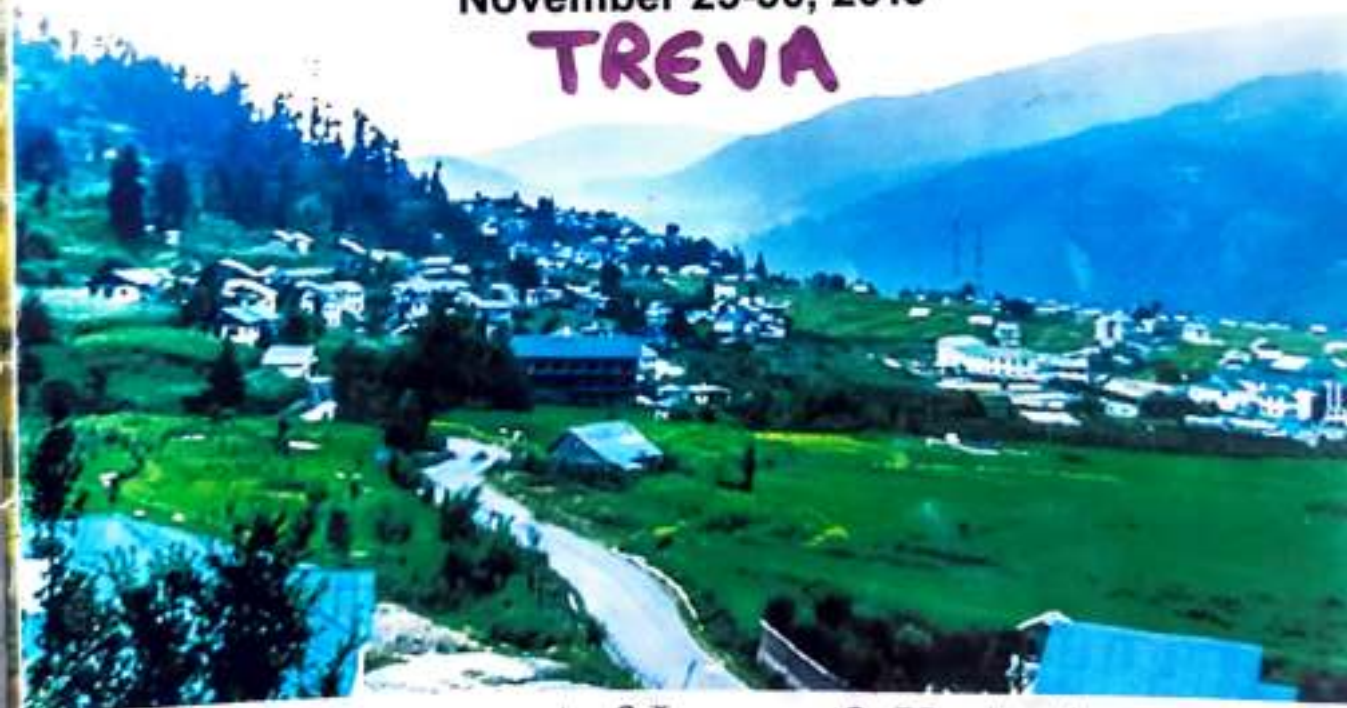

L) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):

An escape bridge is urgently required from Treva to Chok Shera for saving the villagers from shelling from across the border. With this bridge the whole village can be vacated in five minutes which is otherwise impossible. There is no tapped water in whole of the Panchayat. Tapped water supply is urgently required in the Panchayat.

PHC needs to be renovated, sufficient quantity of medicines (Emergency) to be made available along with medical staff. At present only one ayurvedic doctor is available.

Border area benefit should be limited upto 3 kms. At present it is upto 10 kms. Till today no shelling has been recorded beyond 2.5 kms.

Arnia to Treva road to be renovated with black topping. Public transport to be provided from Arnia to Treva.

A large requirement for establishing a Angorcene factory to promote angorcene crop so that the farmers can sell their produce nearby to the factory & increase their income.

Insurance for vehicles should also cover damages occurred due to shelling from across the border.

II Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer: Following complaints were received from public.

1. Patwar Khona, Animal Husbandry centre and PHC, Panchayat ghar buildings are in very bad shape.
2. No. of approach for PM Gram Sakshari Yojna should be increased
3. There is no compensation for crops damaged due to naturally calamities
4. Blockade of existing canal should be immediately removed to increase irrigation facility to the farmers.

5. There is very poor attendance of the Govt. departments in the gram sabha organised by the Panchayat from time to time.
6. Salaries of Sarpanch and Panches should be enhanced (Demand by Panchayat)


Overall perception of functioning of the government:

general perception of functioning of the govt. is very poor among the rural public. There is very general attendance of the govt. officers for rural area. Patroon, Doctor, animal husbandry staff is rarely available to public.

Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

(The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

Such visits are very useful and should be repeated regularly. Also action should be taken on the recommendations made by the visiting officers to produce results for the general public.
