Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):
1. Drinking water is unsafe and no of CA patients are increasing. People attribute it to unsafe water. The water supply scheme is urgent need. <u>✓</u>
2. Power supply: 11kv transmission line be relocated through road to avoid fault. Receiving station be established. Electric poles are urgently needed. <u>✓</u>
3. Lift Irrigation Scheme: Lift irrigation from shallow well to Murdaa can bring more land under cultivation. <u>✓</u>
4. Building for PHC to make it 24x7 functional. Posting of ANM's, NOS, medical officer, lab technician and X-Ray Technician at PHC. <u>✓</u>
5. Widening and improvement of Road from Hyderbagh to Chaudhaseer. <u>✓</u>
6. Development/maintenance of Play ground as the land is available. <u>✓</u>
7. Upgradation of High School to level of H.R. Secondary School. <u>✓</u>
8. Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
Two Private Schools have been given recognition in the village within a circle of 1km upto 10th class. The enrollment of govt schools is very low. In High School enrollment is 69 and in Middle school it is 45. People demand de-recognition of Private schools and make them elementary schools. Teachers in Middle School seem to have hitched tagarung as they are not well versed with schemes. People are not happy with the functioning of schools. <u>✓</u>



III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

People show a negative attitude to B2V2 as promises made in B2V1 are not ~~one~~ fulfilled so far. People are happy if Govt creates accountability in all depths. Govt sponsored education is in shambles and needs corrective measures urgently.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: The villagers are co-operative and aspire to have all the facilities. However, some assessment (the visiting officer shall prepare the overall assessment in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

- ① Closing of Gates at Hyderabad by Army is adding to the problems of people. The alternative road be maintained
- ② PHC be made functional 24x7 the required staff be provided as the posts are sanctioned already.
- ③ Electric poles for LT be provided to avoid transmission of electricity through trees and roof tops
- ④ Water Supply Scheme languishing since long be approved at an earliest as unsafe drinking water is cause of many deadly diseases.
- ⑤ Govt schools should be made accountable and thorough academic as well as administrative audit be conducted along with the action against erring teachers/officials
- ⑥ PRI's be made functional. Election for the Panchayat may be conducted to make it functional
- ⑦ Horticulture/Agriculture dept should conduct an awareness camp regarding diversification of Fruit/Agriculture crops using exotic high density technology.
