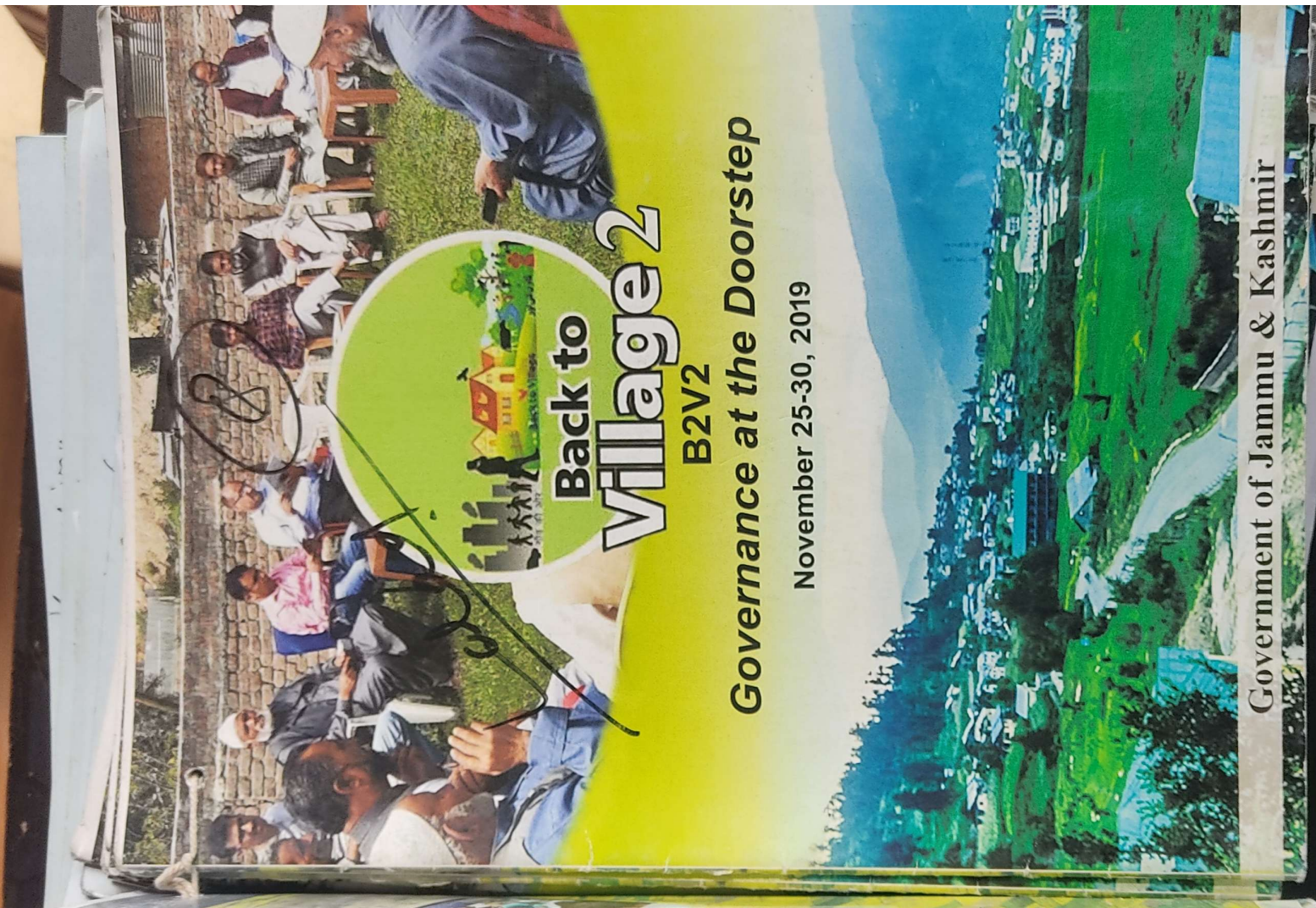

1.	poor drainage facility for undrained, runoff - storm - and sewer water.	
2.	Deficiency of clean and filtered drinking water.	
3.	Shortage of electric poles and Transmission wire for both HT, LT.	
4.	The dilapidated condition of all internal link roads.	
5.	sewerage lines of irrigation canals and meet of lining walls of b-h.	
6.	Lack of Govt. middle and high schools for both boys and girls,	
7.	water logging in the premises of Govt. Primary school and Pandey's Ghar.	
II		Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:
1.	Construction of drainage facility at Govt. Primary school, Pandey's Ghar and Khajwara area.	
2.	Supply of filtered and clean portable drinking water.	
3.	Improvement and modernisation of all internal link roads.	
4.	Replacement of rotten and unsafe wooden electric poles by fresh poles. Provision of transmission electric wires for HT & LT.	
5.	Construction of new PHC and provision of new and safe accommodation for the existing health centre.
