

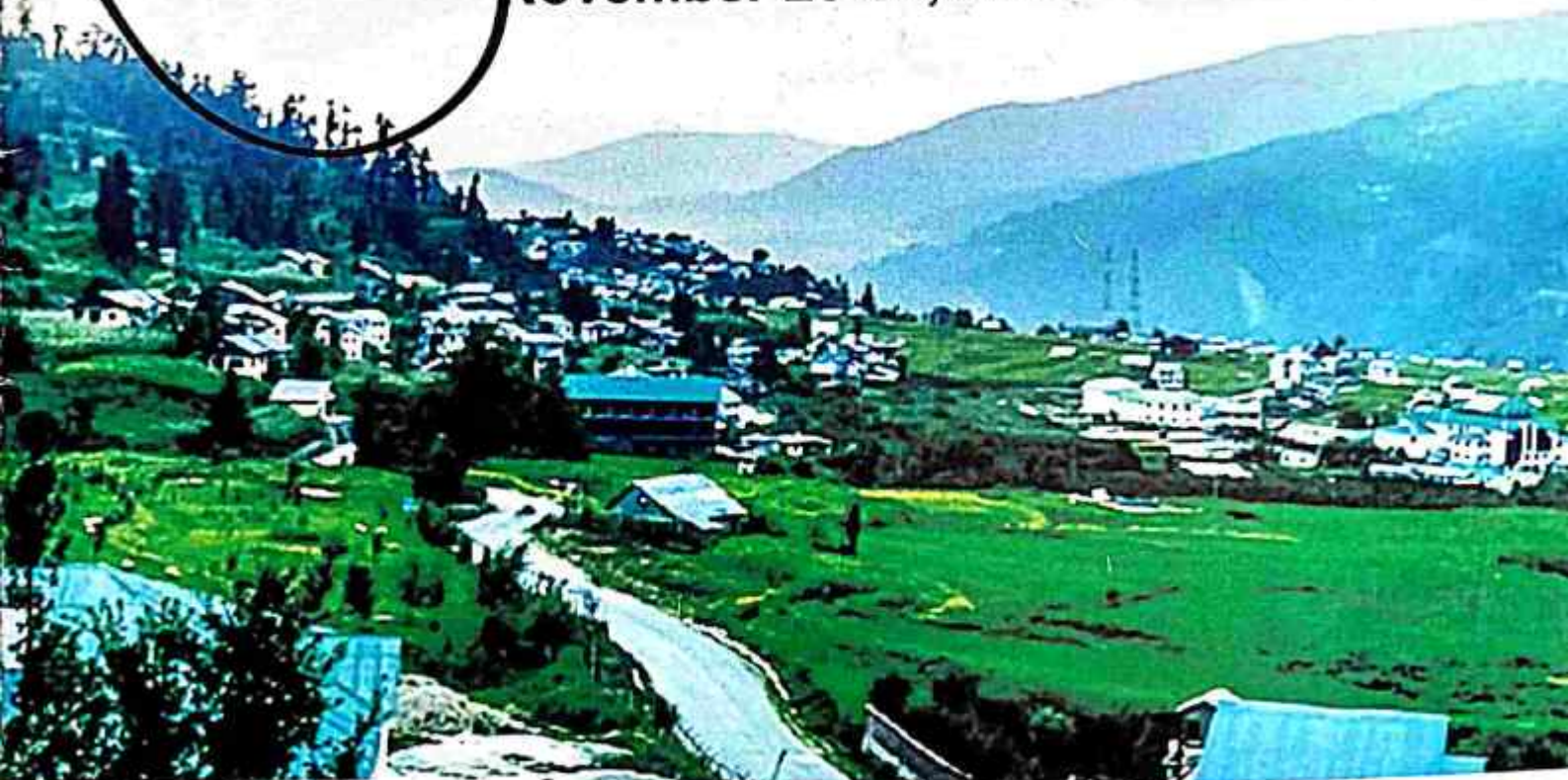

Not a Complaint but during the visit to Panchayat Tudda-B, it was observed by visiting officer that overflow water of "Karka Bowli" (a major source of drinking water) can be used to fulfill the severe water requirement of 90 families living over there.

III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

Government is trying its level best in providing Governance at the door step, but the Projects in the said panchayat are moving at snail's speed. There is dire need to speed up development Projects at the said panchayat as the basic amenities are a far off dream for the inhabitant of the said Panchayat. However, Government is Committed to the same.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

Panchayats are Constituted recently. The members of the Panchayats are Performing well but their performance hampers due to lack of Public Services in the area.
