III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

The Govt. institutions are working in the area but with limited infrastructure and manpower. The people of the area feel neglected because of the apathy shown by different departments in general. The Govt needs to put more effort to bring the common masses to the track of development and growth. Lack of basic facilities like road, education, vocational courses have dragged the area behind.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

The people in general were very much enthusiastic about the first phase of B2V. But this time there was resentment among the masses. Being backward and hilly areas, extra thrust and emphasis is needed to boost the economy. Although the area has potential but certain sectors are still lagging and if emphatically reviewed, many key areas such as Animal Husbandry, Horticulture, Tourism, Agriculture, etc have the potential to grow. In general, people are also very less aware about the different departmental schemes/activities. Extension activities along with provision of adequate infrastructure and manpower can bring desired results.
