

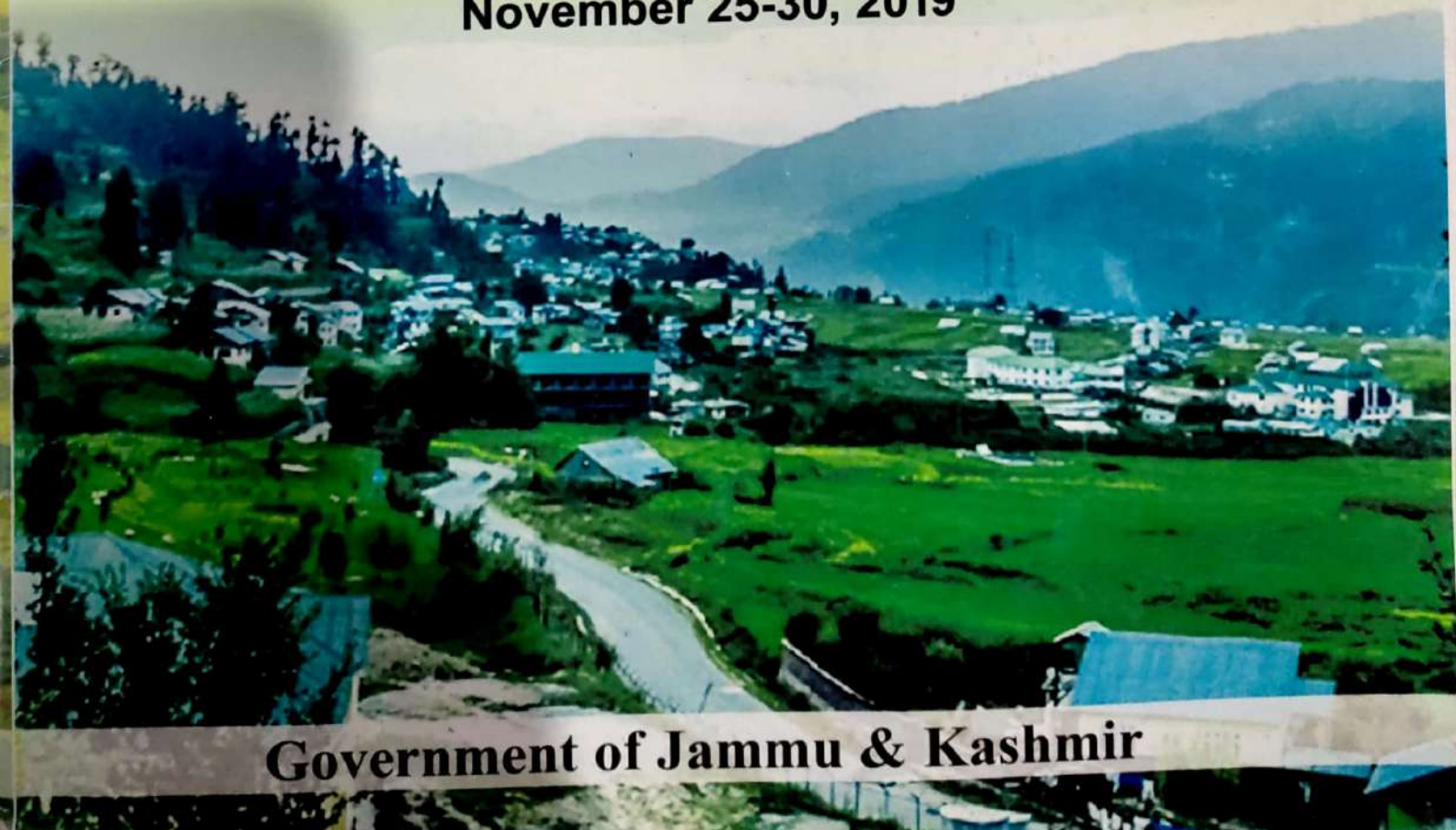

	Providing of disaster relief in the form of monetary ways as well as high density plantations (Apple) and providing of agro-horti mechanical devices to those farmers who are engaged in horticulture sector after proper assessment and prompt rehabilitation of affected farmers in the recently occurred dist. situation.
	Food Security is one of the major issue. About 80% of households are living below line and have demanded BPL & AAY Ration tickets upto 80% under NFSA and local PDS outlet.
(Machanpura)	4. Dismantling of old School building situated at the centre of school ground and const. of new one at the periphery which can increase the space of playground at m/s.
	5. Evacuation of Panchayat - then occupied by the security forces or const. of new one.
	6. Sanction of financial assistance under PMAY to the registered beneficiaries at the earliest and IHHZ under SBM-G.
	7. Improvement and macadamization of inner links, construction of surface drains and polythene & Plastic (waste) disposal pits at their dumping sites.

	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
	The major complaint brought into the notice of visiting officer is that most of the population of Halge, Fedarpura remain unaware and unbenefitted about various social poverty upliftment schemes, be it social, economic or health related, either due to lack of required manpower with the concerned depts or stringent procedures & pre-requisites laid down in the guidelines of such schemes. So, people have strived for flexibility and simplicity, in order to avail various benefits.

III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

Satisfactory to a considerable extent.
But most of the field employees working under various depts are either on consolidated pay / casual / adhoc basis. So, their services are regularized for smooth functioning of govt machinery at grass root level.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

It is suggested that quinquennial camps be organized on quarterly basis, regarding various schemes and funds be kept ready for their utilization at ground level. 	7. Improvement and mecadamisation of Inner links. Construction of surface drains and polythene & plastic (waste) disposal pits at their dumping sites.
