- The people are satisfied with services of RDO, Horticulture, Agriculture, ICDS, Animal and Sheep Husbandry field functionaries. Under MEINKECA should be absorbed in RDO dept so that death of manpower be fulfilled.
- The locals are not happy with government as their demands in B2V1 have not been fulfilled.
- The Anganwari workers should be disbursed their salaries monthly.
- The five departments should listen queries of the people.
