 - Hotel in the area are dumping waste into nallah but construction of toilet latrine near masjid at Izbander is under long pending project.

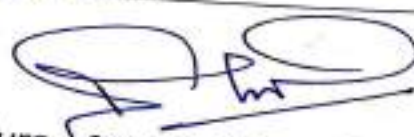
III Overall perception of functioning of the government:
