B2V2/PO&MD/2019 likely was approx 750 thousand. The H/S provided us info that he is unable to provide more if funding amount not cleared.

There is Communication gap between government and general public, it's due to ① The Road Connectivity, officials can't reach well in time to aware the public about the functioning of govt. ② Internet facility should be restored

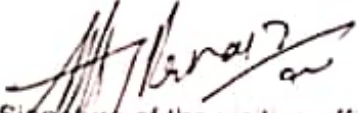
IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:
