Functioning of various department is not good. Inter departmental cooperation is lacking which hampers the development of panchayat. Govt still has much power which proves detrimental to overall functioning of government.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

Visit to Chattergal proved to be very fruitful. People of Chattergal were very cooperative despite being poor. It was not a single demand by B2V2 phase that was fulfilled. People are hopeful that government will provide them at least basic facilities like safe drinking water, upgradation of schools & other health related facilities. My suggestion will be -

- to establish panchayat office as early as possible as it is the main stone for welfare of village.

- Ensure inter-departmental cooperation.
- Provide Sampanch/Panchayat functionaries power as it will hasten the development.
- Ensure adequate staff to some department e.g. Health, Animal/Sheep husbandry as lack of staff creates major problems for people of Chattergal.
