III Overall perception of functioning of the government

There is a need of lot of improvements to be made by Govt sector in improving, health, P.D., P.H.E., Sanitation, PMGSY, AWC, Horticulture, Agriculture sectors. The villagers have the great potential in agriculture, Horticulture, animal and sheep husbandry sector.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

(the visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

There should be the awareness programmes and advisory issued by the departments under one umbrella be given to the villagers a time to time. There is need to renovate Panchayat Ghos which is without electricity and toilet facility and water. There is no permanent veterinary staff in village. Sheep husbandry centre is required at Nalla Mallian. Transport facility is needed in the village.
