|      | Internal roads are well connected & macadamized. Compact clean atmosphere within the vicinity of the village. Scheme run by Social Welfare Deptt are partially implemented and a lot more is required to be done with regard to old age pension, widow pension etc. Villagers are poorly informed about the subsidized schemes being run in agri/horticulture sector for which there is huge scope to improve the economic condition of rural people. Agri. farm owned by Agriculture Deptt for seed multiplication can contribute by way of awareness campaign in the related sector. |

|      | The functioning of Panchayat is observed as average. Panchayat Building with sufficient land available is poorly maintained. Panchayat is not notified till date due to the facts that only one Panch participated in the election & there is no Sarpanch which is reserved for women but no women participated in the election process. Ex-Sarpanch who is the only elected Panch has done a good job and villagers had appreciated his as a social activist and a Panch as well.                                                                                                     |
