

	<p>Pure Drinking water required.</p> <p>1. The water isn't being filtered because the filtration plant isn't working and there is no facility to lift the water from the nearby Canal.</p> <p>Health Issues.</p> <p>2. The panchayat Jalga has a first aid centre but there is no pharmacist available to look after the people.</p> <p>3. The high school in the area needs upgradation for higher education.</p> <p>4. (Horticulture Sector) The area has large horticulture sector thus the required area needs proper maintained road, to facilitate the farmers to lift their fruits easily.</p> <p>5. Proper road connectivity of panchayat Jalga to near by villages and to the Tehsil Headquarter (Vadhpura shahel road and shahel to Upnary hospital).</p> <p>6. The electric facility is poor as the HT lines are rotten and the lift over of LT should be done new transformers should be installed so that over loading is minimised.</p> <p>7. Facilitate the Irrigation Sector of the panchayat Jalga by providing bore wells and proper draining of the area from Sheikhul Alam Ziyarat to Karonag.</p>
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
	<p>(i) Sheikhul Alam Ziyarat needs lift over as the area is a tourism sector point.</p> <p>(ii) Modernisation of inner roads.</p> <p>(iii) Fencing of high school ground.</p> <p>(iv) Waste management should be done by creating waste disposal areas and dust bins.</p> <p>(v) Bakhri shahel need water connectivity and wadipora too needs same.</p>
