

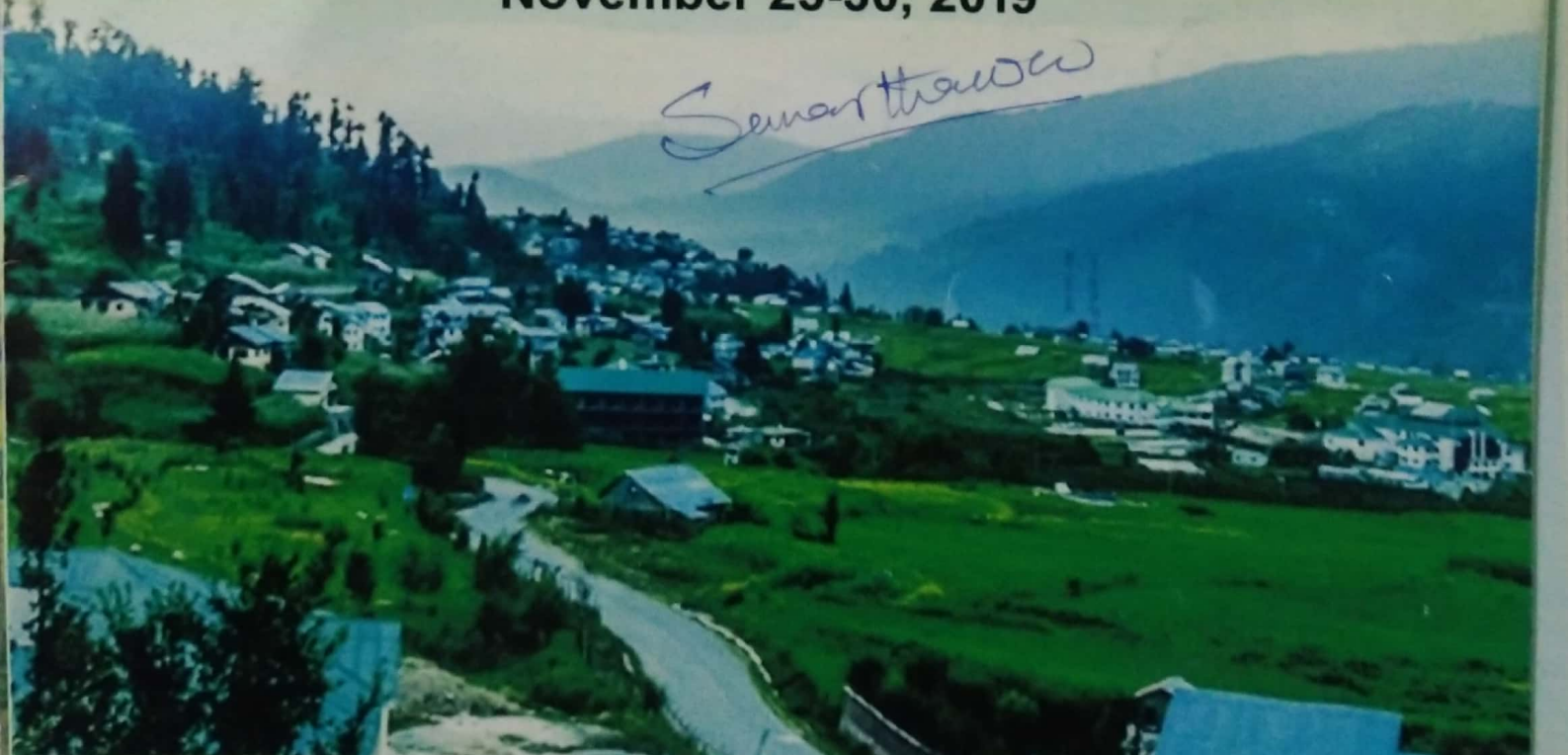

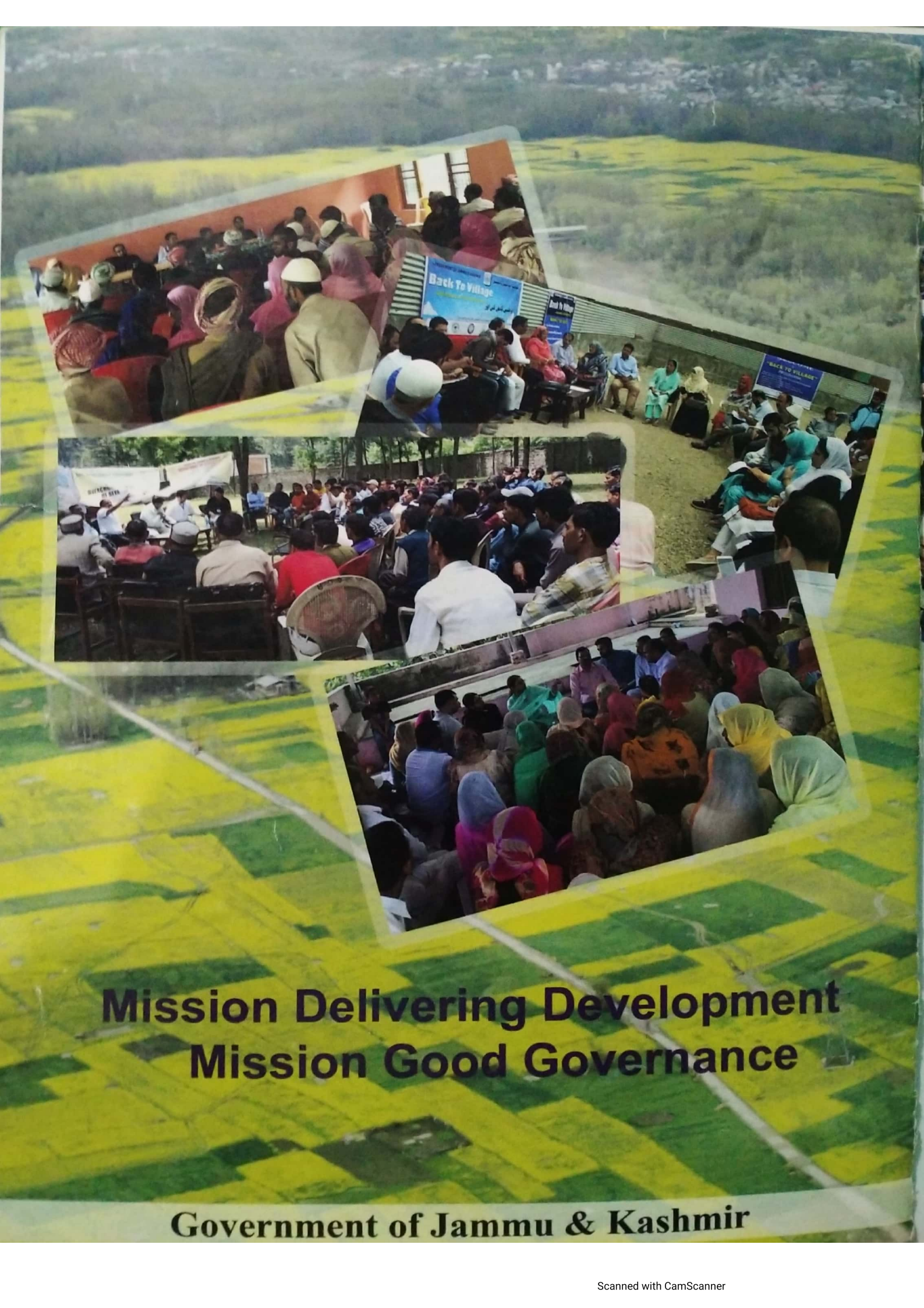
- ① AS THE PANCHAYAT IS DECLERATED ODF FREE, ONLY 50% OF TOILETS
