The people of the area are of the view that all Govt. schemes are very good and beneficial for them but implementation of such schemes does not take place efficiently. Implementation involves delay which increases cost and completion of a particular scheme.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

The visit remained extremely successful - people are quite aware about all the beneficial schemes provided by the Govt. but being very poor they are unable to get the benefit of the schemes as they live from hand to mouth and are unable to spend from their own pocket to start a unit & avail the subsidy provided in any scheme. Besides they are highly anguished and helpless because none of work from B2V has been taken up/completed till date.
