

I	Urgent public requirements in order of priority (Max. 07):
✓ 1.	Augmentation in water Supply Scheme.
2.	Provision of Staff including Hm in high school Jagota where only three teachers are in working position.
✓ 3.	Replacement of wooden poles by PDD as existing poles are not technically fit for catering the electric needs.
4.	Expedition in the Languishing Road projects.
5.	Provision of adequate medicine supply in sub-centre Jagota.
6.	Imordinate delay in sanctioning scholarships for S/C ST and minority students requires redressal.
✓ 7.	Opening of PDS store at convenient place ward (Bhaddan).
II	Any major complaint brought to notice of the Visiting Officer:
	Imordinate delay in the construction of already sanctioned two Road projects viz one from Thelata to Jagota and other from Sikku to Jagota sponsored by PMGSY and CRF respectively. Both projection need intervention of administration to direct concerned agencies to start construction work at the earliest.

III	Overall perception of functioning of the government:
	<p>People have pinned high expectation with the present dispensation, regarding redressal of their long pending demands viz augmentation in infrastructure in all aspects promptness in monitoring and supervising systems. Non-redressal and partial redressal of problems being faced by the people has resulted decrease in participation in Gram Sab and other developmental events etc.</p>

	<p>Number of Complaints in comparison to BVI has decreased during BVI, Attendance/Punctuality in all offices of the Pgt has shown significant improvement. To achieve the objective of doubling the income of the farmers by 2022 or after there is need to supplement the existing agriculture practice with establishment of units like mushroom cultivation, Backyard poultry and conversion of land not in cultivation for horticulture.</p>
