III Overall perception of functioning of the government:

General public of the Gram Panchayat seems to be disagreed as their demands committed in B2V1 not fulfilled till date. They show commitment & poor performance in B2V2 Gram Sabha.

IV Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

General public of the Panchayat participate in low number in B2V2 as compared to B2V1 held in June 2019. People were less enthusiastic as their demands are not fulfilled. Although there is improvement in Govt. functionaries & lot of works has been taken up under MFC & other head schemes but still there are lot of problems due to lack of basic facilities like bad water supply, Kutchha internal roads, low voltage power supply etc. & many more.

As PRI members are empowered with devolution of powers but it has been observed that they are not fully aware of proper functioning of PRI. It is therefore suggested that training sessions on regular basis should be held to make them more capable for improving the working of Panchayat & implementation of various programmes for development of Panchayat.

General public of Panchayat including PRI members are also not aware of numerous welfare schemes launched by Govt. for benefit of general masses so it is being suggested that awareness camps at Panchayat level should be organised to educate the people about the various welfare schemes & getting the maximum benefits of schemes in order to uplift the residents of Panchayat socially & economically. This will also help to stop migration from villages.
